**Day 01**

**1st Day (Mon) BARCELONA (D)**



Arrival at the airport and transfer to your hotel.

Join your Travel Director for your Welcome Dinner at a local restaurant and enjoy the opportunity to get to know your fellow travellers over a delightful evening of good food and wine.

**Day 02****2nd Day (Tue.) BARCELONA (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour of Barcelona. Drive along the main avenues with its impressive Gaudi modernist buildings such as La Pedrera and Casa Batlló. The Montjuic Park with spectacular views of the city and harbor, Olympic Ring, monument to Columbus and the Olympic Port. Visit the most important landmark in the city of Barcelona, Sagrada Familia. Continue to Port Vell to board a catamaran and sail along the beautiful coastline of Barcelona. Upon arrival, the crew will welcome you on board with music, a courtesy drink and a typical local tapa to start the experience in a Mediterranean style. You can sit in the shaded aft seats to feel the sea breeze or lie on the forward nets in the sun to tan and be closer to the sea. This experience is the ideal complement to get to know Barcelona from all perspectives.

**Day 03****3rd Day (Wed.)– BARCELONA-PENÍSCOLA-VALENCIA (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. We set off towards Valencia, following the Costa Dorada and the Ebro Delta until we reached Peñíscola, where we can see the film locations of "El Cid" and "Game of Thrones." We will then continue to Valencia, where we will taste a typical "horchata" (tiger milk) and have the opportunity to explore the city, one of the main capitals of the Mediterranean coast with its modern Arts and Sciences Architectural Complex integrated by six elements: Hemispheric, Umbracle, Science Museum, Oceanographic, Palau de les Arts and Ágora. Explore the old town and the exterior of the most avant-garde complex: Ciudad de las Artes y las Ciencias.

**Day 04****4th Day (Thu.) VALENCIA - GRANADA (B, D)**

After breakfast, we continued towards Andalusia to reach Granada. This city, located at the foot of Sierra Nevada, between the Darro and Genil rivers, is one of the jewels of Andalusia. Here, the impressive Andalusian legacy, represented by the Alhambra, is complemented by Renaissance architectural gems. We will have the chance to learn how to dance flamenco before attending a dinner with a flamenco show in one of the most typical venues in Granada. After dinner, we invite you to take the opportunity to enjoy the wonderful views of Granada from one of the city's viewpoints.

**Day 05****5th Day (Fri.) GRANADA - SEVILLA (B, D)**

After breakfast, visit the world-famous Alhambra complex and Generalife Gardens.

Then, among olive trees and white villages, we continued to Seville, the capital of Andalusia. Tonight, you will have the opportunity to share a typical dinner with your fellow travellers and discover together the traditional Andalusian cuisine.

**Day 06****6th Day (Sat.) SEVILLE (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Morning city tour of the Andalusian Capital, Seville. Visit the Cathedral, the second largest in the Catholic world after St. Peter's in Rome. Continue to Santa Cruz quarter, the natural scenario of Carmen as well as the myth of Don Juan, Maria Luisa Park and Plaza de España.

The afternoon is at leisure for you to enjoy the city of light.

**Day 07****7th Day (Sun.) SEVILLE- CÓRDOBA -MADRID (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Depart for Cordoba, the ancient capital of the caliphate. Arrive in Cordoba and enjoy a tour of its impressive Mosque and its narrow streets of the Jewish Quarter. Continue to Madrid, driving through the natural border of Despeñaperros and along La Mancha, Don Quixote's land. Arrival to Madrid.

**Day 08****8th Day (Mon.) MADRID (B, D)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Discover the beauty of the city with a guided city tour. Barrio de la Morería, the Hapsburgs District, Puerta del Sol, Plaza Mayor and Plaza de la Villa; the Madrid of the Bourbons and the complex town planning schemes of Charles III, the Royal Palace, Cibeles and Neptuno Fountains and the Puerta de Alcalá. Contemporary Madrid with areas such as Gran Vía, Castellana, the district of Salamanca and the emblematic Santiago Bernabéu Football Stadium. During the visit, we will taste the typical chocolate with churros, the most Madrid-style snack. Afternoon at leisure to continue exploring the wonders that the city has to offer. Join your fellow travellers for a tapas dinner in a local restaurant.

**Day 09****9th Day (Tue.) MADRID – SALAMANCA – PORTO (B)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Bound for Portugal, we will drive towards Salamanca. Enjoy some free time in this University City and World Heritage Site of great architectural and artistic wealth. Continue to the Portuguese border to reach Porto. Located along the Douro River estuary in northern Portugal, Porto is one of the oldest European towns, and proclaimed a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1996.

**Day 10****10th Day (Wed.) PORTO (B, D)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Guided sightseeing tour of Porto. Admire the Cathedral, Stock Exchange building and Santa Clara church. Afterwards, enjoy a Douro River Cruise and discover famous Port Wine Cellars with a wine tasting experience included.

Tonight, you will have the opportunity to share a typical fado show with dinner with your fellow travellers.

**Day 11****11th Day (Thu.) PORTO – AVEIRO – COIMBRA (B)**

After breakfast, we depart to Aveiro, known for its picturesque canals, which have earned it the nickname "The Venice of Portugal". We will enjoy a ride on a moliceiro, a traditional colorful boat used for navigating the canals of Aveiro, before heading to Coimbra. We will meet the local guide for a tour of Coimbra, a historic city known for its prestigious university (one of the oldest in Europe), charming medieval streets, and beautiful riverfront.

**Day 12****12th Day (Fri.) COIMBRA – BATALHA --NAZARE – LISBON (B, D)**

Breakfast at the hotel. Departure to the Batalha Monastery, a masterpiece of Gothic and Manueline style considered a World Heritage place by UNESCO. Continue to the picturesque fishing town of Nazaré and time at leisure. Then, we continued to Lisbon.

In Lisbon, we will cross the Tagus River to Cacilhas and enjoy a dinner at a local restaurant featuring seafood.

**Day 13****13th Day (Sat.) LISBON (B)**

After breakfast, join a morning city sightseeing tour of the ancient Olissipo. Afternoon at leisure for you to catch the nostalgic corners of Alfama Quarter, the old city gathered next to its Castle, with old buildings nested in narrow twisting "Ruas" full of colour housing the genuine "tabernas". The rest of the day at leisure to enjoy this magnificent city.
