## Overview

The adventure concludes with a return to Quito and a unique Six Senses tour that immerses travellers in the city's sensory experiences.

## Detailed Itinerary



**Day 01****Day 1 : Arrival In Quito**

Upon arrival in Quito, you will be transferred to your hotel. Nestled in the Andes, Quito is known for its well-preserved colonial architecture and vibrant atmosphere. Spend the evening exploring the city's historic centre or relaxing at your hotel as you prepare for your Amazon adventure.

**Day 02****Day 2 : Quito City Tour And Equator Line**

Embark on a guided tour of Quito, visiting its most iconic sites, including the Cathedral, La Compañía Church, and San Francisco Church. Explore the "Panecillo" hill for a panoramic view of the city and visit the Equator Line complex to experience standing on both hemispheres at the same time. Learn about the region's geography and ancient Andean solar-based traditions at the Ethnographic Museum.

**Day 03****Day 3 : Amazon Cruise - Quito To Coca And The Napo River**

**Day 04****Day 4 : Explore Yasuni National Park**

Visit Yasuni National Park, known for its incredible biodiversity. Look out for the rare pink river dolphin, anacondas, monkeys, and vibrant bird species like the hoatzin. Later, explore a blackwater lake and spot giant otters and manatees. Enjoy a hike through the forest to observe the diverse flora and fauna surrounding the iconic giant fig tree.

**Day 05****Day 5 : Cultural Encounter With A Quechua Family**

Spend the day learning about the culture and traditions of a Quechua family living on the banks of the Napo River. Engage in meaningful conversation and experience daily life in the Amazon. Return to the ship for onboard activities such as a cooking class with the ship's chef, traditional handicraft workshops, or relaxation at the Rainforest Spa.

**Day 06****Day 6 : Forest Adventure And Observation Canopy Tower**

Venture into the forest to observe unique animal and plant species native to the Amazon basin. In the afternoon, climb a canopy tower built on a giant kapok tree for a breathtaking view of the treetops and vast Amazon landscape. Later, take a canoe trip to see black caimans along the riverbank.

**Day 07****Day 7: Return To Quito And Six Senses Tour**

Return to Quito, where you will embark on a Six Senses Tour of the city, engaging all your senses through a unique exploration of local flavours, sounds, and cultural sites. Overnight in Quito.
