Day 01

Day 1: Santiago de Chile

Arrival at Santiago de Chile Airport (SCL) | Meet with your guide.

Private transfer from Airport to selected hotel with English Speaking Assistance – Mineral water on board.

Santiago de Chile is the capital and largest city of Chile, located in the country's Maipo Valley. The city counts with a colonial and European architecture that features a distinctive style that invites thousands of visitors to explore its street full of museums, stores and world-class restaurants. Santiago is one the most vibrant and cosmopolitan cities in Latin America, a city that offers you an unlimited cultural and leisure activity so you can enjoy the most of it.

During the foundation of Santiago in 1641, the Spanish conquerors drew the limits of the city: north, with the Mapocho river as a natural division, was for La Chimba neighborhood, the area for parties, hustle, and bustle, away from the "official city".

Meeting point for mestizos, natives, blacks, half-breed, and poor Spaniards. La Chimba, from Quechua, originally means: "the other gang". The tour covers the national idiosyncrasy, popular culture, and everyday life of the common people of Santiago. Immigration, street art, and religions in Patronato Neighborhood; fruits and vegetables in La Vega Central; history in Plaza de Armas, and many other experiences make up a part of this must-see tour around Santiago de Chile.

Start from your hotel in Santiago. Examine the culture of Santiago through the eyes of a growing group of contemporary Chilean artists. Day 02 Day 2: Valparaiso

Valparaiso Full Day Tour with stop & Lunch at Viñamar Winery.

Private Service (Shared Venues) | Private transfer round trip to the winery | Duration: Full day (8-10 hours approx.) | Guided tour with a bilingual guide and wine tasting are included.

Departure from your hotel towards Casablanca Valley, located just 80 km from Santiago and 41 km from Valparaiso and known mainly by the great production of white wine Sauvignon Blanc, among others. Located at the base of the Cordillera de la Costa and surrounded by 2,500 hectares of native forest, Viñamar Vineyard is highly influenced by the fresh breeze and morning mist from the Pacific Ocean. These conditions moderate the temperatures and establish the ideal conditions for growing white varieties such as Sauvignon Blanc and Chardonnay, as well as reds from the cool climate such as Pinot Noir, Merlot and Syrah. We will have a tour and tasting of sparkling wines in Viñamar.

This vineyard was founded to develop an exceptional line of sparkling still wines for the world's most demanding markets. Aspiring to be recognized for the complexity and originality of its products, Viña Mar has its headquarters in the Casablanca Valley, an emblematic place in Chilean and world winemaking. The winery's name pays tribute to the main virtue of the valley: its beneficial proximity to the sea. It also incorporates the centuries-old tradition of its wine group, characterized by a passion for excellence and uncompromising quality of its wines.

After the tour and tasting at Viñamar, we will continue to Valparaiso (one of the main ports of Chile), declared a Cultural Heritage Site by UNESCO, due to its colorful constructions decorating the hillsides, providing the city a characteristic architecture and unique identity. Here we will visit the main highlights of the city. In the afternoon, return to your hotel in Santiago.
