Day 01

Day 01: Arrive Zurich

Arrival in Zurich. Upon arrival transfer to your hotel. The rest of the day is free to spend at your leisure.

Day 02

Day 02: In Zurich

Today you have a regular city tour in Zurich. Discover this extraordinary city, awarded with the prize as “The city with the best quality of life”. Visit the national museum, the world famous business centre at the “Bahnhofstraße”, the clock of the St. Peter with the largest sphere of Europe, the picturesque Guild houses, the famous opera festivals in June and the Zurich lake. You are going to visit the University of Zurich and the Swiss Federal Institute of Technology (ETH Zurich). The most famous student and professor of the university was Albert Einstein. At the end of the day we stop at the old town to visit the Fraumünster church.

Day 03

Day 03: Zurich - Interlaken

Arrival at the train station on your own. During the afternoon your trip continues to the wonderful city of Interlaken, a city that will leave you breathless. This small city offers a wonderful panorama, located between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz, at the feet of the imposing peaks of Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau.

Day 04

Day 04: Interlaken - Jungfrauoch - Interlaken

After breakfast you visit one of the top must-see points of Switzerland: The “Jungfrauoch - The Top of Europe” that has been declared a natural world heritage by the UNESCO. This is Europe’s highest train station, at an elevation of 3.444 m. Once you are at the top, immerse yourself in a fascinating world of ice and snow. Please do not forget to visit the Ice Palace, a unique ice world in the heart of the glacier, an unforgettable experience that you should not miss.

Day 05

Day 05: Golden Pass Line: Interlaken - Zweisimmen - Montreux

Make your way to the train station and take the train to Zweisimmen, where the Golden Pass Line starts its way to Montreux. Enjoy the ride and the unforgettable views of some of the most beautiful places in Switzerland while traveling comfortably aboard this scenic train.

Day 06

Day 06: Montreux - Zermatt

In the morning make your way to the train station and take the local train to Visp. From there the next train will take you to Zermatt, located at the foot of the impressive Mount Matterhorn. In this town cars are banned in order to preserve its original infrastructure.

Day 07

Day 07: Glacier Express: Zermatt - St. Moritz

After breakfast you board the famous Glacier Express. In the comfortable panorama car you can enjoy spectacular views of the Swiss Alps. St. Moritz is one of the most favourite destinations in Switzerland, regardless of the season of the year this place dazzles you with its beauty, either with a landscape full of snow or with different green shades and summer flowers.

Day 08

Day 08: Bernina Express: St. Moritz - Tirano - Lugano

In the morning make your way to the train station. The first stop of the day is Tirano. In Tirano you see the wonderful novel palace of the XVII and XVIII centuries, this city is famous for its baroque Marian shrine. Then you continue to Lugano which is well known for its incredible scenery, abundant water, dry and sunny climate as well as its mountains and hills.

Day 09: Gotthard Panorama Express: Lugano - Flüelen - Lucerne

Take the Gotthard Panorama Express train to Flüelen. Here you will board the steamboat that will take you to Lucerne through the incredible landscapes offered by the “Vierwaldstätter See” (Lake Lucerne).

Day 10: In Lucerne

Lucerne is one of the most visited tourist destinations in Switzerland. This city has the oldest covered bridge in Europe as well as cobbled streets, baroque churches and historic houses, for example, the luxurious Concert Hall. This famous bridge called “Kapellbrücke” is considered the oldest of Europe and is the icon of this beautiful city.

Day 11: Lucerne - Zurich

Make your way to the train station in Lucerne at your convenience to board the train to Zurich. The tour ends at the Train Station or Airport in Zurich.
