The 20km railway was completed in 1940 and is one of the steepest standard gauge lines in the world. Arrival in Flåm, a village located at the inner end of the Aurlandsfjord. Overnight.

Day 3: Flåm-Bergen

From Flåm board a fjord cruise, as you pass through the Nærøfjord to Gudvangen. The Nærøfjord is listed on UNESCO's world heritage list. Arrival in Gudvangen, an old Viking village with a lot of character. Depart Gudvangen by bus to Bergen. Arrival in Bergen and overnight in a centrally located hotel.
