Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Nairobi

Upon arrival at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Spend the remainder of the day at your leisure, relaxing at the hotel or exploring optional excursions (listed below).

Overnight: Ole Sereni Hotel (Cosy Room, Bed & Breakfast) Check-in Time: Approx. 14:00 hrs

Day 02: Nairobi - Masai Mara National Reserve

After breakfast, depart Nairobi and journey through Kenya's scenic highlands, descending into the Great Rift Valley. En route, drive past the historical chapel built by Italian POWs and the Longonot Earth Satellite Station. Continue via Narok and across golden wheat and barley fields to the world-renowned Masai Mara. Enjoy lunch at your camp, followed by your first exciting afternoon game drive, returning to the camp as the sun sets.

Overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge (Standard Room, Full Board)

Mara Sopa Lodge:

Perched high on the slopes of the Oololaimutia Hills, Masai Mara Sopa Lodge holds the distinction of being one of the first safari lodges established in the Maasai Mara Game Reserve. This legacy is reflected in its lush, mature gardens and towering trees that have flourished over time.

The lodge's architecture draws inspiration from traditional African roundhouses, featuring conical roofs and a layout that gracefully follows the contours of the hillside. At the heart of the property, expansive public spaces and a striking swimming pool serve as central gathering points.

Breakfast lunch and Dinner

Day 03: Masai Mara National Reserve

Start the day with breakfast, followed by a morning game drive, returning mid-morning to relax before lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy another game drive with a visit to a local Masai Village, returning to camp at sunset. Optional: Pre-book a Balloon Safari for a magical aerial experience (additional cost applies).
Overnight: Mara Sopa Lodge (Standard Room, Full Board).

Day 04: Masai Mara ??? Lake Nakuru

Depart the Mara after breakfast, travelling across Kenya's agricultural heartland through Narok to the Rift Valley floor. Arrive at your camp in time for lunch. In the afternoon, enjoy a game drive in Lake Nakuru National Park, known for its birdlife and endangered species, including flamingoes, black and white rhinos, and Rothschild giraffes. Return to the camp at sunset.

Overnight: Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge (Standard Room, Full Board).

Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge:

Set atop a ridge marking the western edge of Africa's Great Rift Valley, Lake Nakuru Sopa Lodge offers sweeping, uninterrupted views across the African landscape. Overlooking the shimmering waters of Lake Nakuru and its surrounding National Park, this lodge is a haven for birdwatchers and wildlife enthusiasts alike.

Day 05: Lake Nakuru - Amboseli National Park

After an early breakfast, head to Lake Naivasha for a tranquil boat ride. Continue south via Nairobi, where you'll stop for a hot lunch or picnic lunch (depending on travel conditions), then journey through the Athi Plains to reach Amboseli National Park by late afternoon.

Overnight: Amboseli Sopa Lodge (Standard Room, Full Board).

Amboseli Sopa Lodge:

Set on 200 acres at the foot of Mount Kilimanjaro, this luxury lodge offers stunning views and a perfect base for exploring the surrounding national park. Just a short distance from where Hemingway wrote *The Snows of Kilimanjaro*, the lodge features 47 spacious en suite rooms, each with a private veranda. Guests enjoy a cosmopolitan buffet of European, African, and Asian cuisine, plus amenities like a pool, multiple bars, a TV lounge, and more—all designed for relaxation and adventure.

Day 06: Amboseli National Park

Enjoy a full day of wildlife viewing in Amboseli, famous for its elephant herds and stunning views of Kilimanjaro. A picnic lunch is included during your game drive. Return to the camp by 16:00 hrs for time to unwind before dinner.

Day 07: Amboseli ??? Nairobi

Following an early breakfast, take in your final glimpses of Mount Kilimanjaro (weather conditions permitting) before departing for Nairobi. Arrive early afternoon. On arrival, guests will be dropped off at Jomo Kenyatta International Airport or their chosen city centre hotel for onward travel plans. End of Services.

Arrival Details:

Earliest Hotel Check-In: 14:00

Early Morning Arrivals: Travellers arriving early are advised to book a pre-night stay at the arrival hotel (additional cost) to ensure immediate room access.

Departure Details

Return to Nairobi: Approximately 13:30 hrs.

Flight Booking Advice: Please schedule any domestic or international flights to depart after 16:30 hrs.

Long Layovers: For extended wait times before flights, consider booking a day room (additional cost, pricing options available on request) to freshen up and repack.

IMPORTANT Luggage Information

Travellers should only bring soft-sided bags on safari. Luggage space in safari vehicles is limited. These bags should measure no more than the following: Height 66 centimetres, Length 42 centimetres, Width 28 centimetres. Soft-sided bags with wheels are permitted.

If travelling on internal flights during your safari, luggage allowances are strictly enforced to 15 kilograms per person, including carry-on bags.

If arriving and departing from the same city, bags can be stored for a one-time fee of AUD 77 per booking, covering both storage and transfer back to you before departure.

Additional remarks

Itinerary adjustments or alternative accommodations may occur due to availability issues.

Park fees, flight prices, and airport taxes are subject to change without prior notice and will be applicable in both current and future bookings.

Internal flight times are subject to change based on airline schedules, load factors and airstrip logistics.
