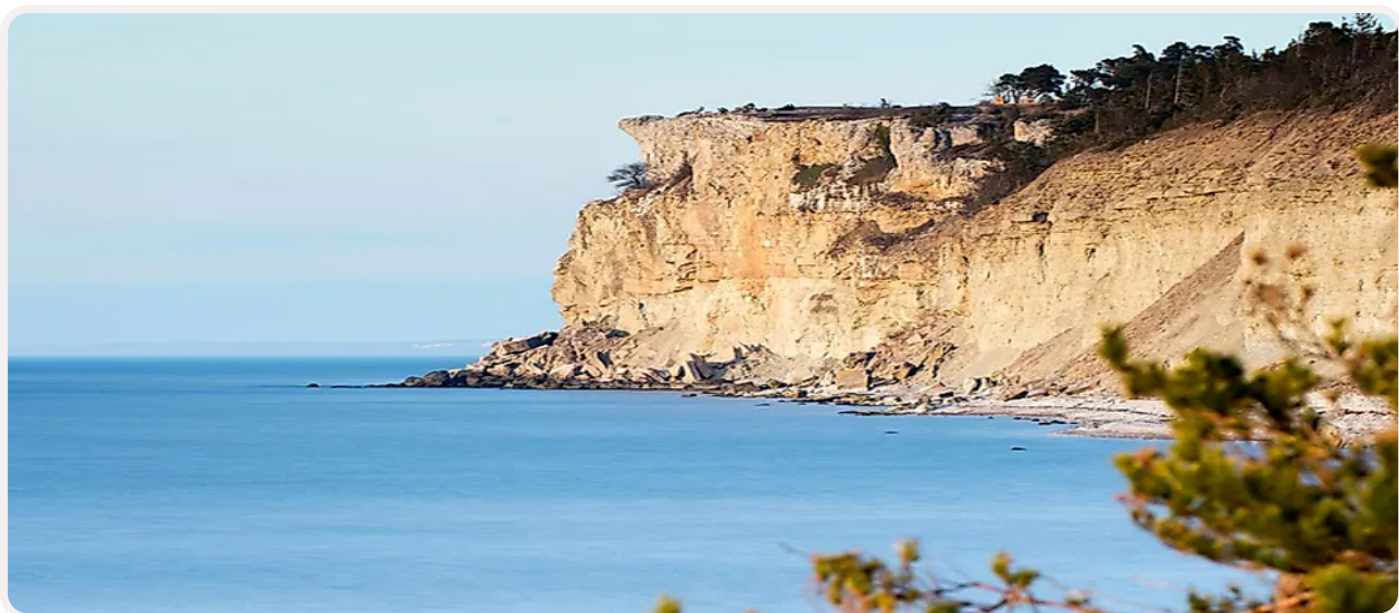

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Stockholm

Arrival in Stockholm, Sweden's capital. Two nights of accommodation are arranged at a centrally located hotel. The remainder of the day is free to explore the waterfront, stroll through Gamla Stan, or enjoy a traditional Swedish meal.

Day 02: Stockholm

Day at leisure in Stockholm. Suggested highlights include the Royal Palace, Gamla Stan, the Vasa Museum, or a boat tour through the archipelago. Optional excursions can be arranged upon request.

Day 03: Stockholm to Helsinki (Overnight Ferry)

Time is available for further exploration in Stockholm. In the afternoon, board the overnight ferry to Helsinki. Onboard amenities include restaurants, entertainment, and panoramic views of the Baltic Sea.

Day 04: Helsinki

Morning arrival in Helsinki. One night of accommodation is arranged in the city centre. The day is at leisure to explore landmarks such as Senate Square, the Helsinki Cathedral, Temppeliaukio Church (Rock Church), and the Market Square.

Day 05: Helsinki-Tallinn

Ferry transfer from Helsinki to Tallinn, Estonia. Two nights of accommodation are provided in a centrally located hotel. The day may be spent exploring Tallinn's UNESCO-listed Old Town, including Toompea Hill and the Alexander Nevsky Cathedral.

Day at leisure in Tallinn. Optional guided activities are available, including a food tour with local tastings. Alternatively, the city can be explored independently—suggested sights include the Estonian Open Air Museum and panoramic walks along the city walls.

Departure by Lux Express coach to Riga, Latvia's capital. Two nights of accommodation are arranged at a centrally located hotel. In the evening, explore Riga's Old Town and enjoy dinner at a local restaurant.

Day at leisure in Riga. Highlights include the Art Nouveau district, Riga Central Market, Bastejkalna Park, the House of the Blackheads, and St. Peter's Church. Optional activities, such as a dinner cruise on the Daugava River, are available.

Day 09: Riga-Vilnius

Coach transfer from Riga to Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania. One night of accommodation is arranged at a centrally located hotel. Suggested highlights include Gediminas Tower, the Gates of Dawn, and the lively streets of the Old Town.
