Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Salamina

As this is the designated arrival day, you have time to explore the Greek capital before you set sail. Athens is one of the world's oldest cities, where you can explore over 3,400 years of history. Buy yourself the multi-site combo tickets for €30 that grants you entry for five days to all the classical sites,

including the Acropolis hilltop and the famed Parthenon structure and six other Archaeological sites: Temple of Zeus, Ancient Agora, Hadrian's Library, Roman Agora, Keramikos Cemetery and Lyceum of Aristotle. The modern Acropolis museum is well worth a visit to learn more and view hundreds of more artefacts.

If you want to see and learn a lot on short time, consider one of the many Athens walking tours on offer – from general city navigation and history, to philosophy, architecture and, of course, food walking tours.

Or stroll the old neighbourhoods from Plake to Psyri, try souvlaki or sip on a frappe, and hang out with the locals in one of the city's many cafes.

In the afternoon, please make your way to our marina in Salamina marina, where you can meet your fellow sailors and mingle.

Relax on board, sip your drink from your private deck, and dance till dawn!

Optional activity: Toga Night.

Day 02: Epidaurus

We continue our Greek sailing adventure and journey towards to the little traditional village of Ancient Epidaurus, famed for its wild lemon trees & oranges, sandy beaches with blue-green waters, lush greenery and fresh fish.

Sunken City and Nisi beach are two of the Epidaurus's best-loved beaches, from which you can explore the Aegean Sea with adrenalin via the massive array of watersports on offer.

There's time to wander picturesque ancient Epidaurus Town, visit the historical ancient amphitheater, and sample some of the best Greek food – and cocktails – on the island.

Optional activity: Epidaurus Scuba diving.

Day 03: Poros

We continue our Greek sailing adventure and journey towards to the little Greek island of Poros, famed for its wild lemon trees, sandy beaches with blue-green waters, lush greenery and Poseidon's Temple ruins.

Love Bay and Askeli are two of the island's best-loved beaches, from which you can explore the Aegean Sea with adrenalin via the massive array of watersports on offer.

There's time to wander picturesque Poros Town, visit the historical Monastery of Zoodochos Pighi and sample some of the best Greek food – and cocktails – on the island.

Optional activity: Poros cooking class.

Day 04: Hydra

Hydra is the island of Greek naval traditions and played a significant role in the 1821 War of Independence, with preserved captain's mansions on the seafront by the quaint Old Harbour, and a

thriving town that remains the heart of commercial life on the island.

Horse-drawn carriages can take you on a romantic journey around the old town streets, and the iconic Cathedral is a must-visit for history lovers.

There are a handful of beaches you can visit, many with water sports facilities, although Vlichos remains a favorite for sun-worshippers as it is considered the most beautiful with its backdrop of pine trees.

We stay overnight in Hydra, allowing time to wander the atmospheric old town at dusk, where you'll find lively bars and clubs. You can even join a late-night party on the beach.

Optional activity: Donkey ride.

Day 05: Ermioni

On the fifth day of our ocean cruising, we sail towards a revered gem of the Aegean – the Ermioni village. With a traditional pebbled road, lined up with cozy tavernas, Ermioni has its charm.. However, its compact size and layout means it's just as easy to navigate on foot, where you can stroll its romantic cobble-stoned backstreets and narrow village walkways.

As the heat rises, spend the afternoon in the calm waters swimming or by SUP (stand-up paddleboarding) in the tranquil bay on the Ermioni coastline, or pass the time idly dining in a tavern, awaiting one of the best sunsets in Greece.

Optional activity: Nafplio bus tour.

Day 06: Aegina

We will moor at the tiny fishing village of Perdika, perched on the idyllic eastern shores of Aegina Island, known for its temple of Athena Aphaia.

Here you can indulge in some the Saronic Islands' best seafood, as well as spend the afternoon swimming in the crystal-clear waters and wandering around the picture-perfect bay, before heading to the taverna-lined harbour for the last Greek island feast.

Day 07: Salamina

After a refreshing morning swim in the sparkling blues of the Aegean Sea, we'll set sail for our final destination on your island-hopping sailing trip. Enjoy the sea breeze and ocean views as you relax onboard.

We'll arrive back in Athens in plenty of time for you to continue your exploration of the city. Our crew will be on hand to give you some top tips and local insights, to find corners of the city you wouldn't otherwise know.

Optional activity: Athens guided tour.

Day 08: Departure day

As we come back in full circle to Athens, this is our departure day, where you'll be saying goodbye to your new friends and your crew.

Hopefully, we will see you again next year for more sailing around the Greek islands.

Note

Our Harmony Greek Island Cruises are a perfect option for those looking for a blend of on-shore cultural and historical sightseeing, coastal relaxation, on-deck sea-view unwinding and the friendly atmosphere of a small ship cruise.

Keep in mind, that as the departure date of the sailing tour comes closer, the prices might increase, so it is wise to book in advance and secure the cheapest price possible!

Standard Cabin Type

All our standard cabins besides, their comfortable mattresses, are ensuite with their own shower, a hair dryer, a wardrobe for storage, reading lights, their own individual A/C device and an electric fan! Regarding our cabins, we do have a variety of doubles/twins (lower beds/bunk beds) and a few triples and quads, depending on your cruise package and demand.

Important Note

The only additional charge you need to expect is the local port fees (AUD 357 per person), which need to be paid upon arrival, in order to assure some basic operational needs for the cruise

Please note that the below itinerary is subject to change due to severe weather conditions or any other unforeseen circumstances. At the unlike event that the itinerary must be altered, we operate our Harmony cruise itinerary instead.

Solo Traveller: If you want to have your own private cabin, there will be an extra charge of 50% of the total amount of 1 person's price.

Meeting Point: Salamina Port

Check-in (Embarkation): Saturday (May-October) at 17:00

Departure: Sunday (May-October) at 09:00

Check-out (Disembarkation): Following Saturday at 09:00

Good to know: The itinerary is subject to change, due to inclement weather, difficulties at docking, or further unforeseen circumstances. This decision will be made solely at your captain's discretion, based on the vessel's and group's safety. If all passengers are onboard before 17:00 on Saturday, the vessel will most probably depart to Salamina, instead of departing the following day on Sunday.

Meeting point: All our vessels embark/disembark on Salamina's Port. We can arrange private transfers to and from your preferred location, tailored to your needs, either before or after your cruise.

Port Information:

All ports we dock at during the cruise, at Salamina's Port, Epidavros, Poros, Hydra, Ermioni, and Aegina are public. This means that all ports we visit, operate on a first-come, first-served basis. For this reason, and especially during the high season (July and August), our vessels typically dock between 2:30 and 4:30 PM to secure a berth for the night. Thus, our Captains are not able to reserve a docking berth beforehand and that is why, the earlier we arrive at each port, the more likely we will find berthing availability. In case of no availability, you will anchor at some mutually agreed secluded cove, around the area.

The only additional expenses passengers need to take into consideration are the local port fees, which all guests need to pay in cash, at their arrival directly to the Captain. The port fees are at AUD 357 per person.

*We cannot guarantee any specific bank ATM at any of the destinations we visit, so we advise you to have cash during the cruise.

Operational and Important Information:

1. All cabin lights, fans, showers, and toilets onboard, work at 24V. Additionally, as the vessels are equipped with batteries that supply an output of 24V, there is no need for an external power supply for the electronics inside your cabin to operate.
2. The onboard Wi-Fi router works only when the vessels are connected to the equivalent port's power supply, or while the onboard generator is working.
3. The A/C on board is working only when the generator is on and running but unfortunately due to local port regulations, generators are prohibited from working after midnight.
4. The power supply from the shores at Zante's Port, Ag. Effimia, Nydri and Ithaca (weak infrastructure) is not powerful enough to operate all our A/C units simultaneously.

Note: The ports we dock at, at Ag. Nikolaos, Fiskardo and Meganisi, do not have electricity at all.

5. The standard daily operating hours for all onboard A/C devices is up to 6 hours and does not include any type of overnight service. For the overnight A/C service, you will have to upgrade your cabin entry, at an additional cost of AUD 333 per person.

6. Onboard cleaning service includes daily basic floor cleaning, dusting, bin changing, bathroom cleaning and the sanitization of all shared areas. During the weekly cruise, our stewards change sheets and bath towels once.

7. Cabin keys are not provided for locking the cabins. If you have personal belongings that you wish to keep secure, you can entrust them to the Captain for safekeeping.

8. Regarding shower water, you can have a shower at any given time of the day.

Keep in mind that when the gulet is docked at any of the ports we visit, the engines are turned off, the water flow is reduced, and thus there is in no warm/hot water after midnight. Also, all water tanks onboard are limited, meaning when multiple cabins shower at once, hot water is likely to run out faster. If this happens, and you do not have warm/hot water available, inform your operating Captain so that he can activate the water heater. After 15 to 20 minutes, you will have warm/hot water again.

In case of any price increase/decrease, you will be informed in time, accordingly. Prices fluctuate regularly, in line with the demand. Our Price Promise ensures clients, who book early, that they will never have to pay more, than those who book quite after them.
