Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: ARRIVAL - VILNIUS

Arrival in Vilnius, private transfer to the hotel, check-in at the hotel.

Day 02: VILNIUS

Breakfast, Vilnius city walking tour with a private guide Lithuania's elegant capital, Vilnius, is celebrated for its rich architectural heritage and warm Old Town atmosphere In the afternoon optional activities can be booked.

Day 03: VILNIUS – TRAKAI – KAUNAS

Breakfast, transfer toward Kaunas. The first stop is the enchanting **Trakai Castle (entrance)**, picturesquely set on an island in Lake Galv?. Here you can stroll across the iconic wooden bridge, explore the medieval courtyards. Continue to the tranquil Pažaislis Monastery and Church (**entrance**), one of the most beautiful examples of Baroque architecture in the Baltics. Arrive in Kaunas, Kaunas city walking tour. Check in at the hotel.

Day 04: KAUNAS – PALANGA – LIEPAJA

Breakfast, depart Kaunas, transfer north toward the Lithuanian seaside. Your route leads to the beloved resort town of Palanga, known for its fresh sea air, sandy beaches, and lively pedestrian promenades, perfect for a refreshing walk along the shoreline. Continue toward Liepaja, upon arrival enjoy a Liepaja city walking tour with a private guide. Check in at the hotel.

Day 05: LIEPAJA – KULDIGA – KEMERI – RIGA

Breakfast, transfer toward one of Latvia's most picturesque small towns: **Kuldīga**. Known for its romantic cobblestone streets and the impressive **Ventas Rumba**, Europe's widest waterfall, Kuldīga offers a beautifully preserved historic center and scenic river views. Continue to Ķemeri National Park, where you can enjoy a short walk on the famous bog boardwalk. Arrive in Riga by afternoon and check in at the hotel.

Day 06: RIGA

Breakfast, Riga city walking tour with private guide, discovering the highlights of Riga's UNESCO-listed Old Town. Landmarks include the House of the Blackheads, St. Peter's Church, Dome Cathedral, Three Brothers, and charming medieval lanes. In the afternoon optional activities can be booked.

Day 07: RIGA – SIGULDA – CĒSIS- TARTU

Breakfast, depart for a scenic transfer into **Gauja National Park**, Latvia's largest and most diverse nature reserve. The journey includes stops in **Sigulda**, known as the "Switzerland of Latvia," where dramatic river valleys and castle ruins create picture-perfect landscapes. Continue to **Cēsis**, a medieval town with a beautifully restored castle complex and a cozy historic center. Arrive in **Tartu**, enjoy a city walking tour with a private guide introduces you to Estonia's oldest university, lively Town Hall Square, and the city's youthful, academic atmosphere. Check in at the hotel.

Day 08: TARTU – TALLINN

Breakfast. leave Tartu for a full-day impression into Estonia's first and largest national park, **Lahemaa**. Nestled along the Gulf of Finland, this region is known for its grand manor estates, forests, and coastal scenery. Visit the beautifully restored Vihula Manor, a historic estate surrounded by parkland and waterways. Enjoy photo stops at Palmse Manor and Sagadi Manor, each showcasing elegant architecture and centuries of noble history. Continue to Tallinn, arrive and check in at the hotel.

Day 09: TALLINN

Breakfast, Tallinn Old Town Walking tour with a private guide of Tallinn's magical Old Town with its well-preserved medieval walls, winding cobblestone streets, Gothic churches, and charming merchant houses. In the afternoon optional activities can be booked.

Day 10: TALLINN – DEPARTURE

Breakfast, departure transfer.
