Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Fàilte gu Alba!

Your adventure in Scotland's capital starts! Meet your private driver and assistant who will transfer you from the airport to the hotel for check in. Once settled, join your private guide for an immersive afternoon walking tour through Edinburgh's cobbled streets and winding closes. Stroll along the historic Royal Mile, where tales of monarchs, poets, and philosophers echo through the centuries, and admire the city's striking contrasts, from the looming grandeur of Edinburgh Castle to the elegant Georgian architecture of the New Town. Along the way, discover hidden courtyards, charming boutiques, and panoramic viewpoints that capture the spirit of this UNESCO World Heritage city. After the tour, why not finish your day with a traditional Scottish haggis in one of the cosy pubs along the Royal Mile! Overnight in Edinburgh.

Day 02: Heading North!

Today with your private driver-guide you will start your adventure north from Edinburgh to Braemar, commencing with a scenic drive across the iconic UNESCO Forth Bridges, spanning 300 years of history and offering breathtaking views of the Firth of Forth. Enroute, stop at the historic Scone Palace, nestled amidst lush greenery, where Scottish kings were once crowned, before continuing to the magnificent Glamis Castle, childhood home of the Queen Mother and steeped in legend and royal heritage. Explore its grand halls and gardens, then journey onward through the stunning Scottish countryside, where the rugged beauty of the Highlands unfolds in rolling hills and charming villages. Finally, arrive in Braemar, a quaint town within the Cairngorms National Park, to unwind amidst serene natural landscapes. Overnight in Braemar.

Day 03: Foraging, Whisky, & Highland Heritage...

After a hearty breakfast in Braemar, meet your private driver and guide for a full-day exploration of the surrounding Highlands. Begin the morning with a private foraging experience, venturing into the wild landscape to discover seasonal herbs, mushrooms, and edible plants under the guidance of an expert local forager. Learn about traditional uses and sustainable harvesting techniques while connecting with the tranquil natural surroundings. Continue to Royal Loch Nagar Distillery to take part in the "Expression Tour, an in-depth experience offering insight into the craft of whisky-making, from the malted barley to the final pour, complemented by a guided tasting of their finest drams. The afternoon allows time for leisurely stops to capture the scenic beauty of Deeside and explore charming Highland villages at your own pace. Later, return to Braemar and unwind with an optional open-fire dining experience at the Clunie Dining Room, before settling in for a restful evening amidst the serenity of the Cairngorms. Overnight in Braemar.

Day 04: Scotland as a Royal...

Today with your private driver-guide you will continue on your delightful journey from Braemar to Aberdeen, beginning with a visit to the majestic Balmoral Castle, the beloved royal residence set against the backdrop of the stunning Cairngorms National Park. Explore the grandeur of its grounds and learn about its royal heritage before setting off towards Aberdeen. Along the way, you will stop at the enchanting Crathes Castle Estate to enjoy a ranger-led private walk, immersing yourself in the tranquility of its woodlands, gardens, and picturesque landscapes. For your last leg of the day, absorb in the beauty of the Dee Valley as you make your way towards Aberdeen, a vibrant city renowned for its historic and granite architecture, cultural attractions, and bustling harbour. Once settled in your hotel, you will be treated to private templars dinner evening, where you will have the opportunity to "dine like a Nobel".

Day 05: Scottish Lairds, Ladies & Highland Coos!

Day 06: Taking the Coastal Road...
