## **Detailed Itinerary**

**Day 01** 

Day 1: Arrival Delhi

Rooms booked from today noon. Meet upon arrival & check-in at Hotel.

**Day 02** 

Day 02: In Delhi

Proceed for a full day sightseeing tour of Old and New Delhi starting with drive past the Red Fort to Jama Masjid followed by rickshaw ride in narrow lanes of Old Delhi. Later continue to New Delhi visiting Indian gate, Parliament house, Sikh





temple and Qutub Minar.

**Day 03** 

Day 03: Delhi-Agra (By Surface: 200 Kms/3 Hours)

After breakfast drive to Agra and check-in at Hotel. Later visit the Agra Fort.

**Day 04** 

Day 04: Agra-Abhaneri-Jaipur (By Surface: 265 kms/5 hours)

Visit Taj Mahal at Sunrise (Closed on Fridays). Later drive to Jaipur en-route visiting stepwells in Chand Baori. Arrive Jaipur and check-in at hotel. Evening is free for strolling in bazaars (Market).

Day 05: Jaipur

Morning proceed for a visit to brief photo stop at Hawa Mahal before visiting Amber fort. Later continue with visit to City palace and observatory. Later free time in local markets.

**Day 06** 

Day 06: Jaipur-Pushkar (by surface: 145 kms/03 hours)

Drive to Holy city of Pushkar. Visit Famous Brahma temple, Holy Lake and several temples scattered around the Ghats of the lake. Enjoy short walk in the local markets.

**Day 07** 

### Day 07: Pushkar – Jodhpur (by surface: 220 kms/04 hours)

After breakfast drive to Jodhpur & check-in at Hotel. Later explore local spice & vegetable market.

**Day 08** 

#### Day 08: Jodhpur

Morning proceed for 5Km long Mehrangarh Fort. This is one of the most impressive and formidable structures in Rajasthan. Visit Jaswant Thada, the tour culminates with a visit to the Museum housed in the majestic Umaid Bhawan Palaces.

### Day 09: Jodhpur – Udaipur (by surface: 260 kms/05 hours)

After breakfast drive to Udaipur en-route visiting Ranakpur, the Jain Temples of Ranakpur, built in the 15th century, are situated in the lovely Aravalli valley. Continue drive to city of lakes Udaipur.

**Day 10** 

#### Day 10: Udaipur

Morning proceed with sightseeing tour of Udaipur visiting the City Palace, the Jagdish Temple built in 1651 is dedicated to Lord Vishnu, the preserver in gardens of the maids-of-honour, with beautiful lawns, gardens and fountains. Later drive around the Fateh Sagar Lake. Enjoy boat cruise on famous Lake Pichola on shared basis

#### Day 11: Udaipur – Mumbai (by flight)





Transfer to airport to board flight to Mumbai. Meet upon arrival check-in at Hotel

**Day 12** 

#### Day 12: In Mumbai

Sightseeing of Mumbai includes visit to the Hanging Gardens on Malabar Hill, the Dhobi Ghats a huge open-air laundry, Mani Bhawan, Victoria Terminus and some free time in local markets.

## Day 13: Mumbai-Chennai (by flight)

Departure transfer to airport to connect flight to Chennai. Meet upon arrival check-in at Hotel.

**Day 14** 

#### Day 14: In Chennai

Proceed with Chennai city tour including 16th Century Kapaleeshwarar temple dedicated to Lord Shiva, sacred to Tamil Shivaties. Non-Hindus are only allowed up to the outer courtyard. Drive past Fort St. George, Marina Beach and San Thome Cathedral. Later visit DakshinaChitra is a center for the living traditions of art, folk performing arts, craft and architecture of India.

## Day 15: Chennai – Puducherry (by surface: 150 kms/3.5 hours)

Drive to Pondicherry & check-in at Hotel. Later proceed for city tour of Pondicherry. Visit Auroville, an 'Ashram' for peace and harmonious living, founded by saint-philosopher Sir Aurobindo. Enjoy walk in the French quarters of Pondicherry.

## Day 16: Puducherry – Tiruchirappalli (by surface: 200 kms/4 hours)

Drive to Trichy en-route visiting famous Brihadishvara Temple in Tanjore. Continue drive to Trichy and check-in at Hotel.

Meal: Breakfast

**Day 17** 

#### Day 17: Tiruchirappalli – Madurai (by surface: 135 kms/3 hours)

After breakfast proceed with sightseeing of Trichy visiting the Rock Fort Temple, dominating the city from atop a most ancient rock. In Srirangam visit the multi-tiered Sri Ranganathaswamy Temple, the largest Hindu temple in India. Later drive to Madurai and check-in at your hotel

**Day 18** 

#### Day 18: In Madurai

On a city tour of Madurai visit the Thirumalai Nayak Mahal built in 1523 and the Gandhi Museum, housed in a 300-year-old palace and dedicated to promoting the Mahatma's teachings. Walk in the bazaar area for some shopping time before visiting the adjacent Meenakshi Temple complex.

**Day 19** 


### Day 19: Madurai – Thekkady (by surface: 140 kms/3.5 hours)

After breakfast drive to Periyar and check-in at Hotel. Afternoon, enjoy a boat ride on lake at Periyar WildLife Sanctuary with opportunity to view wildlife specially elephants, wild boar, sambar, etc.

#### Day 20: Thekkady – Alleppey (by surface: 140 kms/4 hours)





After breakfast Travel to Alleppey to board your kettuvalam, a traditional rice barge houseboat, for an overnight cruise on the tranquil, palm-fringed Kerala backwaters. An onboard chef is at your service preparing local cuisine.

### Day 21: Alleppey – Cochin (by surface: 55 kms/1.5 hours)

Early in the morning you can have the panoramic view of sunrise from your houseboat. After breakfast disembark your houseboat and drive to Cochin. Evening enjoy a Kathakali dance Show

**Day 22** 

#### Day 22: In Cochin

Proceed for sightseeing of Kochi visiting the Dutch Palace, the Jewish Synagogue, St. Francis Church and the Santa Cruz Basilica. Also view the unique and still-in-use "Chinese Fishing Nets" which were introduced by the Chinese traders in the 14th Century. Visit the historical Dutch and Portuguese buildings. Some parts of this nearly 500-year-old Fort are still amazingly well preserved.

Drive to Cochin airport to board flight for onward destination Room till 1200 noon.
