Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: WEDNESDAY - BEIRUT (ARRIVAL)

Arrival at Beirut airport. Meet & Greet by our representative. Passengers arriving individually will be met and greeted, and will have a private transfer. Transfer to your hotel by air-conditioned vehicle. Check in & Overnight in Beirut. Dinner is free.

Day 02: THURSDAY- BEIRUT & BEITEDINNE (100KM)

Breakfast at your hotel. We will start with a briefing meeting at 9h30 am to introduce the group and the guide and explain the trip. Afterwards, we will depart for a half-day guided tour or a visit to Lebanon's capital, which was given the epithet of "bride of the Middle East." We will discover the astonishing Corniche with the Pigeon's Grotto and the renovated downtown, then we will go to the National Museum. Built in 1930, the Museum houses a collection of ancient antiquities covering about 60 Centuries of history. Lunch in the city. In the afternoon, we will head towards the Chouf mountains to discover the Beiteddin Palace and Deir Al Qamar, a symbol of profound Lebanon. Dinner & Overnight in Beirut.

Day 03: FRIDAY: BEIRUT – BAALBECK (100 km) - BEIRUT

Breakfast at the hotel. We will start our tour to Baalbek, which will take approximately 1 hour. Baalbek is famous for its exquisitely detailed yet monumentally scaled temple ruins, when Baalbek, then known as Heliopolis, was one of the largest sanctuaries in the Roman Empire. It is Lebanon's greatest treasure, and it can be counted among the wonders of the ancient world, containing some of the largest and best-preserved ruins. Towering high above the Bekaa plain, their monumental proportions proclaimed the power and wealth of Imperial Rome. The Gods worshipped here, the triad of Jupiter, Venus and Bacchus, were grafted onto the indigenous deities of Hadad, Atargatis and a young male God of fertility. Local influences are also seen in the planning and layout of the temples, which vary from the classic Roman design to other more recent civilisations. We will visit the temple complex made up of Jupiter's Temple, Bacchus Temple, and, adjacent to it and a short distance away, the Temple of Venus. Lunch in the area. Afterwards, we will drive to Ksara, one of the most famous wineries in the region. We will taste a selection of the best white, rose and red wines ever produced in the Middle East. We will continue to Anjar to visit this Umayyad-period town that was excavated only 40 years ago. Return to the hotel in Beirut – Dinner in the hotel and overnight.

Day 04: SATURDAY: BEIRUT – CEDARS – QOZHAYA – QADISHA – BCHARRÉ – BEIRUT (App. 230 Km)

Breakfast at your hotel. Departure towards the North of Lebanon to the region of Bcharreh. Our first stop will be the Monastery of Saint Anthony of Qozhaya, one of the oldest monastic sites in the Holy Valley of Qadisha, renowned for its caves and spiritual heritage. We will then continue into the Qadisha Valley, a UNESCO World Heritage Site also known as the “Holy Valley,” home to countless monasteries and hermitages carved into the rocks. Next, we head to the Cedars of God, a majestic natural reserve suspended at 1,800 meters above sea level. These ancient cedar trees are among the last survivors of the vast forests that once covered Mount Lebanon and remain a proud symbol of the country. Lunch will be served at a local mountain restaurant. In the afternoon, visit the Gibran Museum in Bcharreh, dedicated to the world-famous poet, philosopher, and artist Gibran Khalil Gibran, located in his birthplace. Arrival back to Beirut at the end of the afternoon. Overnight at the hotel. Dinner included.

Day 05: SUNDAY: BEIRUT – JEITA – HARISSA - Byblos - BEIRUT

Breakfast at your hotel. This morning, we will discover the grottoes of Jeita, Lebanon’s natural miracle, a striking nine-kilometre labyrinth of galleries on two levels. The lower river level offers a unique tour by flat-bottom boat past “weeping willows” and gigantic stone flowers. Equally striking is the upper grotto where monumental mineral formations crouch in shady corners. We then continue to Harissa to visit the magnificent statue of Our Lady of Lebanon, offering breathtaking panoramic views over Jounieh Bay. From Harissa, enjoy an exciting cable car ride down to Jounieh, gliding over the bay with spectacular sea and mountain views. Afterwards, drive to the ancient city of Byblos (Jbeil), one of the world’s oldest continuously inhabited cities. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant by the sea or in the old town. In the afternoon, visit the Crusaders’ Castle, the Phoenician ruins, the old souks, and the charming historic harbour that has welcomed civilisations for more than 7,000 years. Return to Beirut in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.

Day 06: MONDAY: BEIRUT – TRIPOLI – BATROUN – BEIRUT

Breakfast at your hotel. Departure towards the North to visit Tripoli, Lebanon’s second-largest city. Begin with a visit to the Crusader Castle of Saint Gilles, overlooking the city, followed by a stroll through the old town with its narrow alleys, traditional souks, hammams, and mosques dating back to the Mamluk and Ottoman periods. Discover the lively Khan El Saboun (Soap Makers’ Courtyard) and

the colourful Khan El Khayyatin (Tailors' Courtyard), both rich in history and craftsmanship. Continue to the coastal town of Batroun, famous for its Phoenician heritage and authentic charm. Here you will enjoy lunch at a local restaurant by the sea, tasting fresh Mediterranean specialities. In the afternoon, explore Batroun's highlights, including the ancient Phoenician sea wall, the old harbour, Saint Stephen's Cathedral, and the charming stone-paved streets lined with traditional houses. Don't miss the chance to try Batroun's famous fresh lemonade, a local speciality. Return to Beirut in the late afternoon. Dinner and overnight at the hotel.
