Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrive Delhi

Meet upon arrival in Delhi & transfer to hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Delhi.

Day 02: Delhi

After Breakfast proceed with sightseeing tour of Old & New Delhi. Old Delhi or Shahjanbad: The city built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan who shifted the Mughal capital here from Agra in the 17th century. Drive past along the river Yamuna past the magnificent Red Fort to one of the largest and most beautiful mosques in the world, the Jama Masjid. Enjoy a cycle rickshaw ride through the narrow lanes of Chandni Chowk, the spine of Old Delhi, past jeweller's spice merchants, food vendors, shopping arcades, workshops as well as residences. Later proceed with visit to Qutab Minar Complex, visiting a myriad of monuments that combine both Islamic calligraphy and Hindu motifs, commemorating the onset of Islamic rule in India. Then proceed to Lutyens's New Delhi, drive past the Rashtrapati Bhawan, (President's Palace), Secretariat Buildings, Parliament House and the India Gate, a war memorial arch built in honour of soldiers who died in the Afghan Wars and World War-I. Visit the Humayun Tomb, the first great example of Mughal architecture in India and regarded as a prototype of the famed Taj Mahal of Agra. Overnight at the hotel in Delhi.

Day 03: Delhi – Agra (by drive: 210 kms/4 hrs approx)

After breakfast, check-out from the hotel & travel by road to Agra. Upon arrival check-in at hotel. Later proceed for Agra Fort & Taj Mahal Agra Fort - Built by Emperor Akbar on the west bank of the river Yamuna and beautified with palaces and gardens by Jahangir, Agra Fort today dominates the centre of the city. Evening visiting the world-famous Taj Mahal built by Shah Jahan in 1630 for his queen Mumtaz Mahal to enshrine her mortal remains. This architectural marvel is a perfectly proportioned masterpiece fashioned from white marble that stands testimony to the skill of 20,000 craftsmen brought together from Persia, Turkey, France and Italy and who took 17 years to complete this 'Love Poem in Marble'. (Taj Mahal is closed on Fridays) Overnight at the hotel in Agra.

Day 04: Agra – Lucknow (by train)

Checkout from the hotel & transfer to railway station to board train for Lucknow DEP: AGRA 0550 HRS 12180 LNJ INTERCITY ARR: LUCKNOW 1145 HRS Meet upon arrival & check-in at hotel Overnight at the hotel in Lucknow.

Day 05: Lucknow

Full day city sightseeing to Lucknow - city of Gardens. It was the 18th-century capital of Nawab Wazirs and a centre of culture and tradition. Visit the great Imam bara, built in the 18th century. The absence of beams and pillars in the huge main hall is an architectural achievement. Also visit Lucknow Residency where the British Resident lived and the Picture Gallery exhibiting excellent full-size portraits of the Nawabs of Oudh. Overnight at the hotel in Lucknow.

Day 06: Lucknow – Varanasi (by train)

Checkout from the hotel & transfer to railway station to board train for Varanasi DEP: LUCKNOW 0700 HRS 14204 LKO BSB INTRCITY ARR: VARANASI 1330 HRS Meet upon arrival & check-in at hotel Evening proceed to downtown area in a rickshaw. Experience Varanasi intimately when you go on a leisurely rickshaw, ride through the narrow streets and alleys of Varanasi. In the evening the Ghats and temples are lit with oil-lamp lights or candles. Participate in an Aarti Ceremony (collective prayer) and watch the floating Diya's (lamps) on the river Ganges. Overnight at the hotel in Varanasi.

Day 07: In Varanasi

Early morning enjoy boat ride on holy river Ganges. The western banks of Ganges has a string of Ghats - the chain of stone steps, all built with pavilions, palaces and terraces, most of which are mainly used as Dharamsala where the pilgrims stay during their visit to the holy city. At dawn, the Ghats are abuzz with activity of the devotees performing their ablutions in the river or offering prayers to the rising sun and performing other religious rituals. A boat ride along the Ghats gives you vantage views of this activity. The sunrise on the Ganges is a soul-lifting experience. Later, visit the Vishwanath temple, also called the golden temple because of the gold-plating on its roof. Return to hotel for breakfast Afternoon: Walk the "Galis" (lanes) and "Mohalla's" (neighbourhoods) of Varanasi and get a glimpse in to the private world of the people who call this ancient city home. An expert will lead you through the serpentine lanes and showcase for you the unique character of each area visited. Also Visit to Bharat Mata Mandir, Durga Temple, Tulsi Manas Mandir, and Banaras Hindu University. Overnight at the hotel in Varanasi.

Day 08: Varanasi – Khajuraho (by flight)

After breakfast transfer to airport to board flight to Khajuraho. DEP: VARANASI 1215 HRS AI – 406 ARR: KHAJURAHO 1440 HRS Meet upon arrival & check-in at hotel. Later visit the Western Group of temples, the most important temple being the Kandariya Mahadeo Temple, dedicated to Lord Shiva. It is one of the largest and most typical of the Khajuraho temples. Visit the Chaunsat Yogini Jain Temple dedicated to the 64 "Yoginis" or attendants of Goddess Kali. This temple stands apart from the rest. Also see the Chitragupta or Bharati Temple with a lovely sculpture of Lord Vishnu in his 11-headed form. The sculptures that adorn the temples depicts gods, Goddesses and amorous couples. The Eastern Group of temples include the Ghantai Temple, Vamana Temple dedicated to the "Vamana" or dwarf incarnation of Lord Vishnu and the Javari Temple. There are also three Jain Temples with beautiful carvings and non-erotic sculptures. Overnight at the hotel in Khajuraho.

Day 09: Khajuraho – Orchha – Jhansi – Delhi (by drive + train)

After breakfast transfer to Jhansi railway station (175 KMS/04 HRS approx.) en-route visiting Orchha. Orchha's grandeur has been captured in stone, frozen in time, a rich legacy of the ages. For this medieval city, the hand of time has rested, and the palaces and the temples built by its Bundela rulers in the 16th and 17th century retain much of their pristine perfection. Jahangir Mahal, a tiered palace crowned by graceful Chhatris, commands a spectacular view of soaring temple-spires and cenotaphs. Thereafter continue drive to Jhansi & board train to Delhi DEP: JHANSI 1520 HRS 12279 TAJ EXPRESS ARR: DELHI 2225 HRS Meet upon arrival & check-in at hotel. Overnight at the hotel in Delhi.
