**Detailed Itinerary**

### **Day 01: Welcome to Athens!**

Upon arrival at Athens International Airport, you will be greeted by our English-speaking assistant and transferred to your hotel for check-in. The rest of the day is yours to enjoy at leisure. Take your first glimpse of Athens by exploring Plaka, the city's oldest district nestled beneath the Acropolis, where you can step back in time and experience the charm of Athens as it was a century ago. Overnight stay at your hotel in Athens.

### **Day 02: Athens Sightseeing Tour**

After your breakfast, depart at the indicated time for your Athens Sightseeing tour.

This morning guided tour gives you an opportunity to observe the striking contrasts that make Athens such a fascinating city. Expert guides will take you to see the Panathenaic Stadium where the first Olympic Games of modern times were held in 1896 (short stop). Continue and pass by the Prime Minister's residence (ex-Royal Palace) guarded by the Euzones in their colorful uniform, the Temple of Olympian Zeus, the Hadrian's Arch, the Parliament and the memorial to the Unknown Soldier, the Academy, the University, the National Library, the Constitution Square (Syntagma). On the Acropolis visit the Architectural Masterpieces of the Golden Age of Athens: The Propylaea, the Temple of Athena Nike, the Erechtheion and finally "the harmony between material and spirit", the monument that "puts order in the mind", the Parthenon.

Continue and visit the place where at last the statues found their home and admire the wonders of the classical era: The Acropolis Museum.

Return to your hotel and remaining of your day at leisure. Overnight stay in Athens.

### **Day 03: Athens port (Piraeus) - Santorini**

After breakfast, a morning transfer is arranged to the port of Piraeus for your ferry journey to Santorini Island, one of the world's most iconic and breathtaking destinations. Upon arrival at the port of Santorini, transfer to your hotel.

The Caldera, crowned with whitewashed villages perched atop its cliffs, offers some of the most breathtaking views in the world. The dramatic scenery of the sunken volcano, the enchanting sunsets, and the island's distinctive volcanic beaches make Santorini a truly unique and unforgettable destination. Overnight at your hotel in Santorini.

### **Day 04: Santorini**

Breakfast at hotel. Day at your disposal to relax and enjoy the island ! Take in the island's legendary volcanic landscapes and mesmerizing sunset views from one of the Caldera villages. The traditional village of Oia is especially famous for its stunning sunsets, where the sun dips below the horizon in a spectacular display of color — a truly unforgettable experience. ### **Day 05: Santorini**

Enjoy breakfast at your hotel, then spend the day at leisure exploring the breathtaking island of Santorini at your own pace.

Visit Fira, the picturesque capital of the island, perched dramatically on the edge of the Caldera. Together with Oia, Imerovigli and Firostefani, these villages form the famous “Caldera’s Eyebrow” — a spectacular balcony overlooking the volcano and the deep blue Aegean Sea.

Explore some of the island's other renowned villages, each offering its own unique charm:

Akrotiri and Messa Vouno – home to fascinating archaeological sites.

Pyrgos, Karterades, and Emporio – traditional settlements rich in history and character.

Ammoudi, Finikia, Perissa, Perivolos, Megalohori, Kamari, Messaria, and Monolithos – each offering distinctive local flavor, beautiful views and the relaxed rhythm of island life.

Overnight at your hotel in Santorini.
