Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Weelcum tae Ulstèr!

Meet your driver on arrival at Belfast Airport for your private transfer to your hotel for check-in. Once settled, set out on a private guided walking tour of Belfast, beginning with a visit to the iconic Titanic Museum. Immerse yourself in the fascinating story of the ill-fated ship as you explore interactive exhibits showcasing Belfast's proud maritime heritage. Afterwards, take a leisurely stroll through the historic streets of the city, soaking in its vibrant atmosphere and admiring landmarks such as Belfast City Hall and the Albert Memorial Clock Tower. Conclude your day at Titanic Distillers, located in the very shipyard where the Titanic was built. Walk in the footsteps of shipyard workers and delve deeper into the city's industrial past with a guided tour and whiskey-tasting session, sampling some of Northern Ireland's finest spirits. Overnight in Belfast.

Day 02: The Causeway Coast awaits...

Today, with your private driver-guide, begin your journey along the picturesque Causeway Coast towards Ballycastle. Travel through Northern Ireland's captivating landscapes, making your first stop in Carrickfergus and its impressive Norman castle that stands as a testament to centuries of history. From here, set sail on a private sea safari along the Antrim coast, gliding past Whitehead's colourful Victorian houses and the historic Blackhead Lighthouse. Continue your adventure on the Gobbins Cliff Path, an engineering masterpiece carved into the cliffs, offering dramatic views of caves, seabirds, and marine life. Declared an Area of Special Scientific Interest, the Gobbins is home to puffins and seals, making it a truly memorable coastal experience. Back on land, journey through the scenic Glens of Antrim, pausing at Glenarm Castle to stroll its elegant gardens before arriving in the charming seaside town of Ballycastle, nestled between rugged cliffs and the open sea. Overnight in Ballycastle.

Day 03: Coastlines, Cliffs and Countryside Horseback Riding!

Meet your private driver-guide this morning as you continue your journey from Ballycastle to Londonderry, beginning with a scenic drive along the coastal road towards Carrick-a-Rede. Cross the exhilarating rope bridge suspended high above the cliffs, originally built by salmon fishermen in 1755, before continuing to the mystical Dark Hedges, a haunting avenue of beech trees made famous by the hit show Game of Thrones. Next, visit the UNESCO-listed Giant's Causeway and marvel at its extraordinary basalt columns formed by ancient volcanic activity. Nearby, marvel at the evocative ruins of Dunluce Castle, perched dramatically above the crashing waves. Before arriving in Londonderry, unwind with a peaceful horse-riding experience through the Irish countryside, where, under expert guidance, you'll bond with your horse and ride through the tranquil Binevenagh Mountains. Conclude the day with a traditional afternoon tea at an 18th-century Irish farmhouse, surrounded by warm hospitality and timeless charm. Overnight in Londonderry.

Nestled in the rolling Maghera countryside, this family-run farm is guided by a fourth-generation shepherd. Learn about the timeless art of sheep herding and shearing with his skilled border collies, as you listen to engaging tales of farm life and family tradition. Return to Belfast, where you may wish to explore its thriving culinary scene before settling in for your final evening. Overnight in Belfast.
