Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Weelcum tae Ulstèr!

Meet your driver on arrival at Belfast airport before your private transfer to your hotel in Belfast for check-in. Once settled, enjoy a private guided walking tour of Belfast with a visit to the iconic Titanic Museum, where you'll immerse yourself in the fascinating history of the ill-fated ship as you explore the exhibits of Belfast's maritime heritage. Afterward, take a stroll through the historic streets of the city, soaking in the vibrant atmosphere and admiring landmarks like Belfast City Hall and the Albert Memorial Clock Tower. Conclude your day with a visit to Titanic Distillers, based in the very shipyard where the Titanic was built. Walk in the footsteps of the shipyard workers and immerse yourself in history as you enjoy a guided tour and tasting session, experiencing the art of whiskey-making while savouring some of Northern Ireland's finest spirits. Overnight in Belfast.

Day 02: The Causeway Coast awaits...

Today with your private driver-guide, you will start your journey along the picturesque Causeway Coast towards Ballycastle. Traversing through the captivating landscapes of Northern Ireland, your first stop is in Carrickfergus, where the imposing Carrickfergus Castle stands as a testament to centuries of history. Here you will set sail on a private sea safari, beginning with a visit to Whitehead, a Victorian village with colourful houses facing the sea, known as the "Town With No Streets" due to its unique road names. Explore the historic Blackhead Lighthouse, guiding ships since 1901, before experiencing the engineering marvel of the Gobbins Victorian Cliff Path Walk, offering views of caves and marine life. Declared an Area of Special Scientific Interest, the Gobbins hosts diverse wildlife, including puffins and seals, making it an adventure for all. Once back on land, wind your way through the enchanting Glens of Antrim, where lush green valleys and cascading waterfalls greet you at every turn. Pause for a moment of serenity at Glenarm Castle, its elegant architecture surrounded by meticulously manicured gardens. Finally, arrive at Ballycastle, a charming coastal town nestled between the rugged cliffs and the expansive sea. Overnight in Ballycastle.

Day 03: Coastlines, Cliffs and the mystic Dark Hedges!

Meet your private driver-guide this morning as you embark on an enchanting journey from Ballycastle to Londonderry, beginning with a scenic drive along the coastal road towards Carrick-a-Rede. Traverse the exhilarating rope bridge suspended over the stunning cliffs, built by Salmon fishermen in 1755. Next, immerse yourself in the mystical aura of the Dark Hedges, an enchanting avenue of beech trees made famous by the hit show Game of Thrones. Continue your adventure to the UNESCO-listed Giant's Causeway, marvelling at the hexagonal basalt columns formed by ancient volcanic activity, before taking a step back in time at the haunting ruins of Dunluce Castle, perched dramatically on a cliff edge overlooking the tumultuous sea. Before heading into Londonderry, enjoy a scenic horse-riding experience in the serene Irish countryside, where you will begin, through expert guidance and grooming,

by bonding with your horse. Then you will journey through the picturesque landscape, taking in the natural beauty and tranquillity of the Binevenagh Mountains, before concluding the tour with a traditional afternoon tea at an Irish farmhouse, built in the 1700s. Overnight in Londonderry.

Day 04: Historic Londonderry and fun at the farm!

Start your day in Londonderry by immersing yourself in its rich history with a walking tour of the city's iconic landmarks, such as the historic walls, Peace Bridge and the Guildhall. After exploring the city's cultural heritage, meet your driver guide and embark on a scenic journey towards Belfast, making a memorable stop at Glenshane Country Farm for an authentic rural experience. Located deep in County Derry's stunning Maghera countryside and guided by a fourth-generation shepherd. Experience the timeless art of sheep herding through a bond with his border collies, before witnessing sheep shearing as you listen to tales of farm life and family heritage. Head back to Belfast, where you may indulge in its thriving culinary scene before relaxing for the night. Overnight in Belfast.
