Day 01: Fáilte go hÉirinn!

A warm greeting from your driver on arrival at Dublin airport before your private transfer to your hotel in Dublin for check in. Then, indulge in a private tour of DK Connemara Oysters, where you'll uncover the secrets of oyster cultivation while sampling these exquisite delicacies straight from the pristine waters of the Atlantic, along with a fine bottle of bubbly. To make the day even more memorable, board the Killary Fjord boat tour, gliding across Ireland's only fjord for incredible vistas and tranquil waters.
