### Detailed Itinerary

**Day 01: Aqaba Port (arrival for Meet & Assist with entry visa) (1 hour) Wadi Rum**

Meet & assist by our representative at the port of Aqaba for entry visa (who will be waiting for you to get your luggage and clear customs and he will be holding the sign board under your name) you meet your guide then Transfer to Wadi Rum desert to meet our local team their, pick up by local Jeep to your camp for Bedouin dinner & overnight.

**Day 02: Wadi Rum (2 hours) Little Petra (15 min) Wadi Musa (Petra)**

After your breakfast, Check out then Departure to explore Wadi Rum the desert of Lawrence with 4 hours jeep tour , visits to the vast silent landscape of ancient riverbeds, pastel colored stretches of sandy desert and amazing rock formations known as Jebels that rise from the desert floor, the deserts cape of Wadi Rum represents some of the most stunning countryside on the planet. The world's mountain climbers and hikers, attracted by its many as yet unsealed peaks, have recently discovered Wadi Rum's spectacular natural scenery and comfortable year round climate. In the afternoon Drive to visit the Little Petra ( Beidah ) then transfer to your hotel in the down town of wadi Musa for overnight.

**Day 03: Full day Petra**

After your breakfast, full day exploring Petra through the winding gorge to a Magnificent city carved out of rose red rock 2000 years ago by the Nabatean Arabs, Petra is the treasure of ancient world, hidden behind an almost impenetrable barrier of rugged mountains, boasting incomparable scenes that make it the most majestic and imposing ancient site still standing nomads. The rock carved rose Red city of Petra is full of mysterious charm, it was "designed to strike wonder into all who entered it". Transfer back to your hotel for overnight.

After your breakfast, a second full day visit in Petra then return to your hotel for overnight.

### **Day 05: Petra(3 hours)Dead Sea(Entrance & Lunch) (30 min)Mount Nebo(10 min)Madaba(45 min)Amman**

After your breakfast, check out by road to proceed for Dead Sea near the Jordan River, the lowest point on Earth 409 meters below sea level, It is also one of the world's saltiest bodies of water, with 33.7% salinity (You can not sink, you will float). The Dead Sea area has become a major centre for health research and treatment for several reasons, free time at Leisure for swimming & lunch. In the afternoon, visit Mount Nebo (Moses Memorial) last stop, you can enjoy the panoramic view of the Holy Land of Dead Sea & Jerusalem & Bethlehem. Then visit Madaba (City of Mosaics), where you will see the unique map of the Holy Land in St. George Church 6th C. AD. Madaba and its hinterlands were repeatedly mentioned in the Old Testament as Madaba. Continue to Amman for overnight.

### **Day 06: Amman(45 min)Jerash(35 min)Ajloun(1 hour)Umm Qais(2 hours)Amman**

After your breakfast, proceed to visit Jerash or Gerasa. This is the second major site in Jordan after Petra. Today considered one of the best preserved Roman provincial towns in the Near East. The heyday of Gerasa dates from the 2nd and 3rd centuries with cobbled streets, colonnades, immense temples on the crest of hills, charming theaters, spacious public squares, thermal baths, fountains and walls pierced by towers and gates. Then proceed to Ajloun visiting Al Rabad Castle, the 12th century Castle built by one of Salahdin's lieutenants in the campaign against the Crusaders. Drive to visit Um Qais, It was the home of several classical poets and philosophers, including Theodoros, founder of a rhetorical school in Rome, Gadara hanging on a splendid hilltop overlooking the Jordan Valley and the Sea of Galilee, which is known today as Umm Qais, and has an impressive colonnaded street, a vaulted terrace, and the ruins of two theatres. Back to Amman hotel for overnight.
