Day 01: Airport – Colombo

Arrive to Sri Lanka, transfer to Hotel in Colombo, Colombo City tour.

Fort, the former British administrative center and military garrison, Sea Street - the Goldsmith’s quarters in the heart of Pettah, the Bazaar area, a Hindu Temple with elaborate stone carvings and the Dutch Church of Wolfendhal dating back to 1749.
