**Day 01: Arrival Addis Ababa**

## Day 02: Addis Ababa-Semera-Ert'ale

Breakfast at the hotel Check out, meet your English-Speaking Driver-Guide and transfer to the Bole International Airport for your flight to Semera City. Arrival in Semera Airport, travel by road to the foot of the volcano, driving through the Afar region, occasionally coming across nomads with camels. Enjoy lunch at the Salt Lake, here the concentration of salt is no less than that of Dead Sea. While lunch is being prepared Take a dip in the lake, and then wash off the salt in a hot spring. After lunch continue your way to the volcano, the asphalt is replaced by a dirt road, and on the horizon, you will already see the breath of a volcano. By sunset you will arrive at the camp and begin the ascent. Light trekking for about 40 minutes to reach the crater. Here you will be on the edge of a volcano, above you the starry sky, and under you the lava river splashes and seethes, the is only a few places in the world as such. Dinner will be at the camp site. The night will be spent under the starry sky, camping.

## Day 03: Ert'ale-Hamed Ella

At dawn, those who wish, together with a guide, will be able to climb the volcano again and see it in the daylight. After breakfast, drive through lava fields to the small village of Hamad Ale in the hottest place on Earth. Enjoy lunch at the campsite, after lunch take a drive to the village, where the hospitable Afar women will treat you to traditional coffee. Go to Lake Assal, the picture that you will see is impressive imagination, for tens of kilometers, the glass surface of one of the saltiest lakes in the world. You will see local "millionaires" in the extraction of salt. Further, your path will lie in an unusual place- a city of salt. These are huge salt rocks in the middle of the lake. This place is often used in the filming of episodes of science fiction films. You have seen salt, the city of salt, and what is under the layer of salt. After 7 meters of salt, an underground lake begins, and you will go to the part where the lake is very close to the surface. Take a swim in the hot spring, which is located 116 meters below sea level. End the day in one of the most unusual sunsets of your life. Return to the camp for dinner.

### Day 04: Hamed Ella-Dallol-Semera

After visiting the Colourful sulfuric acid, head back to Semera. On the way you will have a stop for lunch. Arrival into Semera, enjoy the rest of the day at leisure Dinner at the hotel.

### Day 05: Semera-Addis Ababa-Awassa

### Day 06: Awassa-Arbaminch

After breakfast we will visit the fish market near lake Awassa and then we head further south to the town of Arba Minch. Here we will get acquainted with the representatives of the first tribe Dorze (Dorze) Dorze lives in South Ethiopia and occupies a rather respected position among other tribes. Representatives of the tribe live quite high in the mountains, enjoying breathtaking views of the valley, belong to the Ethiopian Orthodox Church (which is very rare, most of the tribes who converted to Christianity in South Ethiopia are Protestants), Dorze also weave cotton of incredible quality and beauty, bake delicious cakes (Kocho), collect honey and drink excellent local vodka. The tribe is famous for its unique houses that look like elephant heads, bee hives, or maybe inverted baskets. In any case, the lifespan of such a house is 100 years. Let's take a closer look at their way of life. Find out what can be made from the leaves of the "false banana", and why they deliberately make their houses so tall.

### Day 07: Arbaminch-Jinka

After breakfast at the resort, depart for Jinka, the only settlement in the region that can be called a city. You will get acquainted with the fashionable tribe Bena. The men of this tribe make headdresses from clay and decorate with feathers. Get to learn about the wild traditions that they still have. Some of the members of the tribe do not like to walk on the ground, they use stilts.

### Day 08: Jinka- Mursi village- Turmi

Today you will go to the Mursi tribe, the most famous tribe of the Omo River Valley. On the way, you will drive through the Mago National Park, where, in addition to the mountainous green Ethiopian landscapes, the guide will try to have you see animals. Mursi is the most recognizable and photographed tribe in the south of Ethiopia. The women of the tribe wear huge plates in their lower lip, and they live in small, thatched huts. After lunch you will visit the Hamar tribe. The women of the tribe wear heavy rings around their necks, confirming their status as a wife, and their hair is braided in clay dreadlocks. The tribesmen adorn their bodies with scars and wear many ornaments made of multicolored beads. If lucky you will get to the Bull Jumping ceremony. This is a traditional Hamar rite that every boy goes through to becoming a man. He will only become a man only after running naked on the backs of the bulls lined up in a row. Visit the local market, where you can see representatives of several tribes. Head to the lodge, dinner will be at the lodge.

### Day 09: Turmi

Breakfast at the lodge. Today you will visit the gallery, the gallery of body painting. Patterns, ornaments and even scars on the body of the Karo tribe can be viewed endlessly. And Kalashnikov assault rifles, with which they protect their property from other tribes, give the tribe a "wild, but not primitive look". They are the most artistic tribe in the Omo valley. Afternoon if the day is Monday or Tuesday, you will enjoy the market.

Breakfast at the lodge In the morning visit the village of Omorate on the banks of the Omo River. Take a wooden boat and cross over to the other side of the Omo. Meet with the Dassanech tribe.

### Day 11: Konso- Arbaminch- Addis

After breakfast we visit the Konso tribe. Konso is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. This is not surprising, since the Konso are considered one of the first African tribes to master agriculture. And Konso make amazing sculptures and masks from wood. Depart to Arbaminch to catch your flight to Addis Ababa. Arrival into Addis Ababa visit the Ethnological Museum, enjoy lunch and souvenir shopping, evening farewell dinner at one of the city's best traditional restaurants enjoying a variety of Ethiopian cuisines and watch traditional dancing transfer. Transfer to the Bole International Airport for your night flight onwards End of services.
