Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Bodrum

Our exciting journey begins in Bodrum, where you board the boat at 16:30. After the necessary briefings, you'll have time to explore the important places of the city. You can take a leisurely walk through Bodrum's narrow and charming streets, passing by restaurants and cafes. If all passengers arrive before 18:30, our boat will set sail and anchor in the nearest cove for dinner. Otherwise, the gullet will stay anchored in Bodrum harbour for the night. We would like you to consider this information while plan your flight to Bodrum. Dinner is served on board, but if the boat remains anchored in Bodrum harbour, for those arriving after 21:30, a simple meal box (sandwich, fruit, etc.) will be provided. If this is the case, you can enjoy the VIP massage service on board and experience Bodrum's famous Saturday night.

Day 02: Orak Island – Çökertme

We start the day with breakfast and set sail for Orak Island. Here, you can take a refreshing swim in the crystal blue waters before heading to Çökertme, a charming fishing village, for lunch and dinner. The evening meal and overnight stay take place in this lovely village. Those who wish can enjoy a short walk by the sea in this area.

Day 03: Long Port - Ayinda Bay

In the early morning hours, we head towards the Seven Islands. After visiting Küfre Bay in the Seven Islands, we anchor at Uzun Liman. Here, you can enjoy a swim and have lunch. Later, we set sail for Ayinda Bay for dinner and overnight stay.

Day 04: Cleopatra Island– Karacasögüt

We start the day by heading to Sedir (Cleopatra) Island. With its unique tiny sandy beach and ancient ruins, this island is like an open-air museum. In the afternoon, we drop anchor at Karacasögüt. Dinner and overnight accommodation take place in this peaceful harbour. Today, if you choose to join the optional Dalyan tour, we will dock the boat in English Harbour for those not participating in the tour, and the visit to Sedir (Cleopatra) Island will be postponed to the next day.

Day 05: Longoz-Tuzla

After starting the day with a morning swim, we anchor at Löngöz Bay, a paradise surrounded by pine forests, for lunch. From here, we head to Tuzla Bay, where you can swim in turquoise waters. Dinner and overnight stay take place in this beautiful bay.

Day 06: Karg?l? – Kisebükü (Alak?sla Bükü)

We arrive in Karg?l? Bay (Molla Ibrahim Bay) in the early hours. After lunch on board, we set sail for Kisebuku (Alak?sla Bay). You can explore Byzantine ruins on the beach. Accommodation and dinner will be held in this lovely bay.

Day 07: Pabuç Burnu – Yal?çiftlik – Bodrum

After breakfast, we head to Pabucburnu / Yalıciftlik. Our guests who desire can Join our optional half-day village tour from this point. Afterwards our Gulet set sails to our last stop, Bodrum Harbour. Dinner will not be served on board.

Day 08: Bodrum

Disembarkation by 10:00 a.m. after breakfast.

Inclusion

- Breakfast, Lunch, Snacks, 6 Dinners.
- Coffee and Tea during breakfast and snack times, drinking water during all meals.
- Crew service.
- Diesel & Gasoline expenses.

Note

IMPORTANT NOTE: The A/C can be in use up to 8 hours daily, the use of A/C in Harbours is strictly forbidden.

Departure Days: Every Saturday - First departure on May 17th / Last departure on October 11th.

Port Charges extra to be paid while booking.

Please note that the prices are starting from and that upon sending a new request with specific date we will send the applicable rate and availability.

Other Information:

- Air conditioning is centrally controlled, can be used for up to 6 hours per day, and its timing is determined by the captain.
- The use of air conditioning during port stays is strictly prohibited by the port authority.
- Children under 10 years old are not included in cabin charter tours.
- Wi-Fi is available on our boats and is subject to a fee.
- Each cabin has a private WC/Shower.
- Optional land tours and bar payments are accepted in cash. Credit/debit cards are not accepted on the boats.
- Bringing food and drinks from outside is prohibited.
- The tour is conducted by air-conditioned wooden gulets ranging from 20-47 meters in length, with 4-16 cabins.
- The Gulet company , we reserve the right to make necessary changes to the boat or route due to operational difficulties, sea conditions, sea traffic, and weather, to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests.
