Adjusting to altitude in Cusco and Titilaka can take time; stay hydrated and avoid strenuous activity upon arrival.

Weather Preparedness

Lima: Mild with occasional coastal fog, temperatures between 60°F and 75°F (15°C to 24°C).

Cusco: Cool and crisp, particularly in the mornings and evenings, with temperatures ranging from 40°F to 68°F (4°C to 20°C). Bring warm layers.

Lake Titicaca: Similar to Cusco, with cool nights and sunny days. Sun protection is crucial at high altitudes.

Fitness Requirements

Moderate fitness is required for walking tours in Cusco and Machu Picchu. Altitude can make even light activities more demanding, so it's important to take it slow and allow time for acclimatization.
