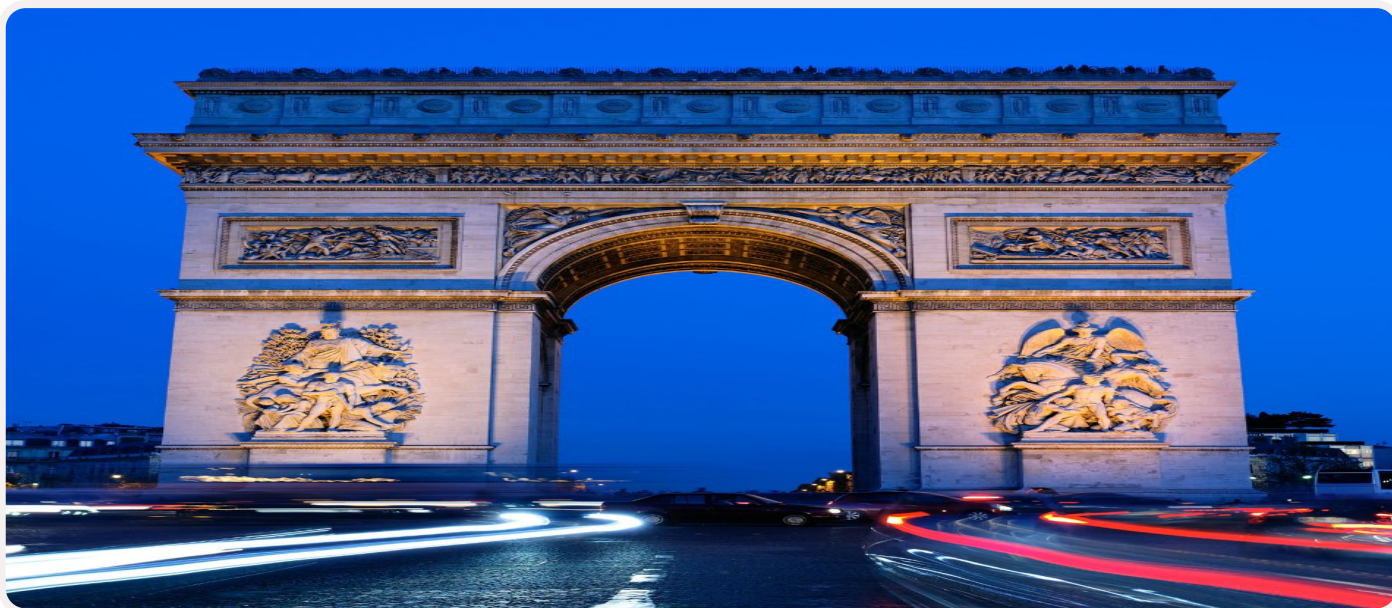

Day 01: Welcome to Paris, the city of light!

At Moët & Chandon, enjoy their signature tour, discovering the history, tradition, and artistry behind their world-renowned champagnes, followed by a tasting of their exquisite bubbly. Continue your journey through picturesque Gothic villages scattered across the countryside, and visit Reims with its UNESCO-listed cathedral. Stop in the village of Hautvillers to see the tomb of Dom Pérignon, the Benedictine monk considered the godfather of Champagne. Cap off your day with a visit to a charming, family-run estate, where you will explore intimate cellars and enjoy additional tastings, experiencing firsthand the craftsmanship that has made this region legendary. Overnight in Paris.

Day 04: Escape to the Château...

Meet your private English-speaking driver guide before setting out to discover the charm of the Loire Valley and its magnificent castles. Begin your journey at the magnificent Château de Chambord, commissioned by King Francis and possibly influenced by Leonardo da Vinci. The Château is a sprawling national game reserve and architectural marvel, boasting over 400 rooms, a 156-meter facade, 282 chimneys, and a remarkable double helix staircase. Next, travel to Amboise for a guided tour of Château du Clos Lucé, where Leonardo da Vinci spent his final years. Explore his living quarters, Renaissance rooms, and inventions displayed throughout the castle and park. Conclude your tour with a visit to the captivating Château de Chenonceau, known as the "Chateau des Dames" for its ties to influential women. This castle, enriched by figures like Diane de Poitiers and Catherine de Medici, showcases a rich feminine legacy. Admire the grand entrance door, bearing historical inscriptions, and the iconic Salamander emblem of King Francis I. Overnight in Paris.
