Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Welcome to Iceland

Individual transfer by Fly bus shuttle bus from Keflavík International Airport to your accommodation in Reykjavík, where you spend the night. Today you may explore Iceland's capital city on your own if time allows.

Day 02: Volcano Crater, Fjords & Mountains

At 09:00, meet our tour guide and depart from Reykjavík Natura Berjaya Iceland Hotels. Travel west to the town of Borgarnes. Easy hike on Grábrók volcano crater in the middle of a greenish lava field. Further north visit Glaumbær, one of Iceland's most beautiful turf house farms and folk museums. Continue along scenic fjord landscape and over several mountain passes until we reach Akureyri, the capital of North Iceland. The overnight location at allows you to walk around the beautiful town of Akureyri.

Day 03: The Capital of North Iceland, Lake Mývatn & Geothermal baths

In the morning, explore the town of Akureyri, also called the capital of North Iceland, and admire the panoramic view over the Eyjafjörður fjord.

Optional whale watching tours are available at 09:00.

In the afternoon, travel to Goðafoss, the waterfalls of the Gods. Then explore Lake Mývatn, known as a geological wonderland and for its abundant birdlife. See the strange lava formations at Kálfaströnd, the pseudo craters at Skútustaðir and the tephra cone Hverfjall. Finally, end the afternoon relaxing in the geothermal Mývatn Nature Baths with a fantastic view over the whole area.

Day 04: Lava Labyrinth, Hot springs & Travel East

In the morning, walk in the lava labyrinth at Dimmuborgir, “the dark castles”, hoping to get a glimpse of the trolls who are said to live there. In the afternoon, visit the hot spring area of Námaskarð with bubbling mud pools and steaming solfataras. Head through the uninhabited highlands and moon-like surroundings to East Iceland. From June to August, the tour includes a detour to the powerful waterfall Dettifoss.

Day 05: East Fjords, Glacier Lagoon & Diamond Beach

It's a day to admire the dramatic fjord landscape and its tiny fishing villages at the end of twisty roads in the East Fjords and, on the route, visit an attractive stone and mineral collection. Then, in the afternoon, see Vatnajökull – Europe's biggest glacier visible all over Southeast Iceland. We end the day with a stop at Jökulsárlón glacial lagoon filled with floating icebergs, exploring the extraordinary site and might see seals swimming in the arctic waters. A boat tour between floating icebergs is included in the program from May through October. You can walk on the black sandy beach (The Diamond Beach) where large icebergs get stranded.

Day 06: Vatnajökull National Park & South Coast

Travel along the southern part of the glacier Vatnajökull and get a glimpse at Europe's second-largest national park, which has Iceland's highest mountains, an alpine environment, and Europe's largest glacier.

In the afternoon, a beautiful drive with many natural wonders awaits us as we head across the Eldhraun lava field, cross the sandy desert of the south coast, overlooked by mountainous cliffs, glaciers and waterfalls. Experience the unique Icelandic Lava Show where you get to witness and feel the heat from molten lava! Stroll along the black lava beach of Reynisfjara near Vík. In the small village of Skógar, there is Skógafoss waterfall which is 60 meters high and is one of the most impressive waterfalls in the country. Continue to the high but narrow Seljalandsfoss waterfall, which plunges over the mountain. An exciting trail goes behind the fall – if you are prepared to get wet!

Day 07: Icelandic Horses & Golden Circle

Explore classics today as we travel the route of the Golden Circle sights. Start the day at Friðheimar, where you learn about the Icelandic horse, its unique qualities and history and visit a geothermal greenhouse. Later on, see steam from the Geysir geothermal fields as we arrive. There is a variety of hot springs and bubbling pools. The original geyser is now dormant but has been replaced by Strokkur, “the Churn”, which erupts at 5-7 minute intervals. Continue to Gullfoss, “the golden falls”, a double waterfall that tumbles 32 meters into the Hvítá river and attracts travellers in summer and winter. Travel inland to Thingvellir National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site. As we return to Reykjavík, we will take you for a short city tour to show highlights of the world’s northernmost capital.

Day 08: Blue Lagoon

Depart by bus (no guide) and drive through rough lava fields to the Blue Lagoon, where you can relax in its rejuvenating geothermal water. The water is rich in minerals and believed to have healing powers. The afternoon is free at leisure to explore Reykjavik, Iceland’s capital, or enjoy an optional spa treatment at the Blue Lagoon. Entrance fee and towel included.

Day 09: Travel to West Greenland, Ilulissat city walk & Icefiord sunset cruise

Airport transfer from your accommodation to Keflavik international airport for a 3-hour flight to Ilulissat. Transfer to your accommodation. After the welcome meeting with your local guide, enjoy a guided city walk of Ilulissat. Afterwards, you have some time to explore the town, visit the local museum and observe Greenlandic life at the always busy harbour. Welcome dinner (2-course) is included at your hotel in Ilulissat.

Around 22:00, we depart for a sunset cruise to the famous Ilulissat Ice fiord, the world's largest ice sculpture park. The experience is overwhelming; the lights and colours constantly change. Enjoy a late drink on "the real rocks". The tour duration is about 3 hours. Dress warmly.

(Note: The season for midnight sun is approx. May 22-Jul 24. Outside this season, the excursion is operated as an evening cruise with the beautiful sunset reflecting over the icebergs).

Day 10: Inuit Settlement at the Ilulissat Icefiord

Breakfast at the hotel. Travel by bus as far as the road goes, then continue on a guided walk to the old Inuit settlement of Sermermiut at the UNESCO-listed Ilulissat Icefjord. Various Inuit cultures lived here over the past 4,000 years, and remains from ancient settlement layers can still be seen. Learn about local traditions and history before European contact, and enjoy views across the icebergs.

Walking distance: approx. 3 km round-trip. Hiking time: approx. 1 hour. Terrain: mainly track bridge with some uneven and rocky sections. Total tour duration: approx. 3 hours.

After the hike, visit a local family for a home visit or kaffemik, a traditional social gathering in Greenland. Kaffemik is an opportunity to share coffee and cake, see national costumes and learn about local life in a remote Arctic community. Duration: approx. 1.5 hours.

Day 11: Whale safari in Disko Bay

Breakfast at the hotel. Today you join a whale safari in Disko Bay, one of the best areas in Greenland for whale sightings during the summer season. The boat heads into the bay where humpback whales are often seen feeding near the surface. Your guide shares insights into whale behaviour and the seasonal migration patterns that bring them to this part of West Greenland.

Enjoy the views of the surrounding icebergs as you search for whales before returning to Ilulissat.

Tour duration: approx. 3 hours.

Day 12: Boat trip to Eqi - the calving glacier

Breakfast at the hotel. Early morning departure for the one-day boat trip to Eqi – the calving glacier. The Eqi glacier runs into the fjord 80 km north of Ilulissat and is one of the most beautiful places in Greenland. It is possible to get very close to the 5-km wide glacier front and experience huge pieces of ice breaking off. The sound of an active calving glacier is quite remarkable, while the sight of icebergs toppling into the water is breathtaking. Tour duration: about 6.5 hours.

Day 13: Travel back to Iceland

Breakfast at the hotel. Spend some time in the morning exploring the town of Ilulissat and last-minute Greenland shopping. Then, return by flight to Keflavik and stay two nights in Iceland's capital. Airport transfers are included, both in Greenland and Iceland.

Day 14: Lava Tunnel

Depart by bus (no guide) and get the chance to explore the magnificent lava tunnel Raufarhólshellir, one of the longest and best-known lava tubes in Iceland. The tour takes about 3 hours with approximately 55-60 minutes inside the cave.

Important: Trips to Greenland are always subject to weather, fog and ice conditions. Therefore the sequence of the day tours and excursions in Greenland is subject to change, or if needed, an alternative excursion will be operated if available. In addition, delays and flight cancellations between Iceland and Greenland can happen. Therefore we strongly recommend you buy travel insurance in the country of residence to cover any additional travel expenses should your flights be delayed or cancelled due to weather. We recommend not to book any international flight directly after a trip from Greenland. Ideally, stay a minimum of two nights in Iceland after the Greenland trip to avoid the risk of missing an international flight.
