Day 01: Arrival Stockholm

The tour begins in Sweden's capital, a city rich in history, charm, and waterfront beauty. Time can be spent exploring the old town's winding alleyways, museums, and castles.

Travel north to Umeå, Northern Sweden's cultural capital. A variety of museums offer insight into the region's rich heritage.

Arrival in Luleå, home to Gammelstad, a UNESCO-listed church town with deep ties to Sámi culture. A visit here provides insight into this fascinating part of Swedish history.

The journey turns south toward Kiruna, a mining town with a rich industrial heritage. A stop at the world-famous ICEHOTEL provides a chance to admire intricate ice art and enjoy a drink at the ice bar.

Day 11: Kiruna - Jokkmokk

A visit to Jokkmokk, renowned for its annual Sámi market, offers further immersion into Sámi culture. In autumn, there is still a chance to see the Northern Lights.

Clients will pass the tracks of the famous Inlandsbana – the local train network. If they have time to spare be sure to jump on board and enjoy beautiful scenery.
