**Visit:** Muscat-Quriyat-Wadi Shab-Muscat

### Detailed Itinerary

**Day 01: Wadi Shab (4WD)- “Coastal Trek” & Bhima Sinkhole Duration – 8 hours approx.**

Travel through the Coast from Muscat to Quriyat and over the plateau down to the narrow coastal track. Reach Wadi Shab and take a hike up one of Oman's scenic wadis. At the end of Wadi Shab, there is a swim through the famous keyhole into the secluded world of thrilling fantasy. Trek back and you definitely need well well-deserved lunch. Head towards the local restaurant. After Lunch, continue towards white sands "Fins Beach". Enjoy the waves and beauty. After driving towards the Bimah sinkhole (Hawaiyat Najm park), a geological wonder. Start back to Muscat with a photo stop at Quriyat town from the highway. Return to Muscat.

**(Kindly note that the wadi is strewn with rocks and pebbles, which makes walking difficult. Advisable to wear sturdy, reef, walking shoes).**

### **Note**

#### **Dress Code During Tours**

-Swimming in Wadis – Wadis are a public tourist area and hence, they attract both tourists & locals equally. Keeping in mind the country's culture, all women are requested to wear clothes up to the knees. T-shirts & shorts are fine. However, bikinis only are not recommended.

-Trekking - Take as little as possible, as conditions are usually steep and hot. Boots are required and they should be lightweight but beware of the aggressive nature of the rocks. Trekking shoes and light-coloured clothes are advisable.

-During other tours – Smart casuals are suitable, especially if visiting local villages and meeting local people.

-(Kindly note that the wadi is strewn with rocks and pebbles, which makes walking difficult. Advisable to wear sturdy, reef, walking shoes).
