Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Prague

Welcome to Europe! On arrival at Prague airport, a private transfer will take you to the hotel. Overnight in Prague.

Day 02: Prague

After breakfast, a private guided tour will give you an introduction to the main sights of Prague: In the Prague Castle area, admire the Archbishop's Palace, St. Vitus Cathedral and the Royal Palace. Also visit the old city with its Jewish quarter and the old town square with several lovely monuments, such as the Týn church, the St. Nicholas church and the town hall and astronomical clock. Overnight in Prague.

Day 03: Prague – Cesky Krumlov

A private driver will take you from Prague to Cesky Krumlov. Enjoy a private guided walking tour to this picturesque medieval town in southern Bohemia, famous for its beautifully preserved old town, winding cobblestone streets, and the majestic castle overlooking a bend of the Vltava River. The UNESCO-listed historic center is filled with colorful Renaissance and Baroque buildings, charming cafés, artisan shops, and panoramic viewpoints. Overnight in Cesky Krumlov.

Day 04: Cesky Krumlov – Vienna

A private driver will take you from Cesky Krumlov to Vienna, the grandiose capital of Austria. In the afternoon, a private guided walking tour will show you the most important sights of Vienna: admire the Opera, the Hofburg Palace, the Heroes' Gate, the Parliament and the Town Hall (outside visits). Overnight in Vienna.

Day 05: Vienna

For today you have tickets to visit the Spanish Horse Riding School in Vienna, one of the world's most prestigious equestrian institutions, dedicated to preserving the classical art of horse riding. Located in the heart of the city, this historic school is home to the famous Lipizzaner stallions and is a living testament to over 450 years of Habsburg equestrian tradition. Its elegant Baroque Winter Riding School and Renaissance stables have made it a must-visit attraction for history lovers, families, and horse enthusiasts alike. (Visit to the horse training or morning show on request.). In the evening, you can attend a concert with live classical music (not included). Overnight in Vienna.

Day 06: Vienna – Bratislava – Vienna

A private driver will take you from Vienna to Bratislava. Here a private guided walking tour will show you the historic center of the capital of Slovakia, that sits on the banks of the Danube River. The city combines a charming medieval old town with modern urban life. You might want to explore Bratislava Castle, stroll through cobblestone streets lined with colorful buildings and enjoy riverside cafés. Travel back to Budapest on the Danube river with the Twin City Liner catamaran. Overnight in Vienna.

Day 07: Vienna – Györ – Budapest

After breakfast, start with your private driver from Vienna via Györ to Budapest. Györ, located at the confluence of the Rába, Rábca, and Mosoni-Danube rivers, is a showcase of elegant Baroque architecture, with beautifully restored squares, ornate churches, and colorful townhouses. A private guided tour will show you the highlights, including the Basilica of Györ, the Bishops' Castle, and the Town Hall. After the visit, continue to Budapest. Overnight in Budapest.

In the morning, enjoy a private guided walking tour to get to know the capital of Hungary, a vibrant city divided by the Danube River into Buda and Pest. Chain Bridge. Overnight in Budapest.
