Visit: Montego Bay-Ocho Rios-Port Antonio-Kingston-Montego Bay

Detailed Itinerary

Day 01: Arrival in Montego Bay

Guests arrive at the Montego Bay International Airport (MBJ) and are warmly welcomed. Transfer to their respective hotel for check-in and relaxation after the flight. Overnight: Montego Bay.

Day 02: Montego Bay Shopping, Highlights & Greenwood Great House

After breakfast, enjoy a day exploring Montego Bay. Guests will experience local shopping, a scenic highlights tour of the city, and a guided visit of the historic Greenwood Great House, one of the Caribbean's best-preserved plantation homes. Overnight: Montego Bay.

Day 03: Montego Bay - Ocho Rios via Falmouth & Dunn's River Falls

Depart Montego Bay and travel along the north coast. Stop for a guided tour of historic Falmouth, known for its Georgian architecture. Continue to Dunn's River Falls, where guests may climb the cascading waterfall or relax on the beach. Arrive in Ocho Rios for evening leisure. Overnight: Ocho Rios.

Day 04: Ocho Rios - Port Antonio | Sun Valley Plantation & Frenchman's Cove

Day 07: Kingston Discovery: Bob Marley Museum, Devon House & Beverly Hills Viewpoint

- A guided tour of the Bob Marley Museum, former home of the reggae icon.
- Visit to Devon House and time to enjoy the famous Devon House I-Scream.
- A scenic drive through Beverly Hills, offering panoramic views of Kingston City.
- Take a scenic ride over to the serene South Coast.

Overnight: Treasure Beach

Day 08: Black River Safari, YS Falls & Appleton Estate

A full day exploring the natural and cultural attractions of the South Coast:

- Black River Safari boat ride to spot crocodiles and mangrove wildlife.
- YS Falls, where guests can enjoy swimming, viewpoints, or zip-lining.
- Appleton Estate Rum Tour, featuring tastings and a behind-the-scenes look at rum production.

Overnight: Treasure Beach

Day 09: Pelican Bar Experience - Return to Montego Bay

Enjoy a scenic boat ride to the world-famous Floyd's Pelican Bar, located on a sandbar in the Caribbean Sea. After this unique experience, travel from Treasure Beach back to Montego Bay. Overnight: Montego Bay.
