Day 01

DAY 1 – GRAVESEND - ROCHESTER

Continue south and reach the Lympne Safari Park for an exciting overnight: here you have the chance to sleep in glamping tents and wake up with a magnificent view on the camp and its iconic animals! Overnight: Lympne area.

DAY 4 – HYTHE AND DOVER

Embark today on a steam train journey from Hythe along the scenic Kent coast up to Dungeness - you won't be disappointed! The white cliffs of Dover are then waiting for you to admire one of UK's most popular and stunning view over France and the rest of Europe. Overnight: Canterbury area.
