Detailed Itinerary



Day 01

Day 1 : Baltra and Santa Cruz Island

Your journey begins at Dragon Hill on the northern shore of Santa Cruz Island. The trail takes you past a brackish lagoon frequented by shorebirds and flamingos, leading to a lookout with panoramic views of the western islands. You'll also encounter land iguanas basking in the sun, a fascinating introduction to the wildlife of the Galapagos.

Day 02

Day 2 : Isabela And Fernandina Islands

Start with a dinghy ride along Punta Vicente Roca on Isabela Island. This region is known for its unique geology and abundant marine life, where you might see flightless cormorants, penguins, and green sea turtles. In the afternoon, explore Punta Espinoza on Fernandina Island, the youngest and one of the most pristine in the archipelago. Marvel at the dense population of marine iguanas and the diverse species that thrive in this untouched environment.

Day 03

Day 3 : Santa Cruz Island

Visit the Charles Darwin Research Station, home to a giant tortoise breeding program and the heart of Galapagos conservation efforts. Afterward, head to the lush highlands for a different perspective of the island's ecosystem, where giant tortoises roam freely among volcanic landscapes and tropical vegetation.

Day 04

Day 4 : Floreana Island

Begin with a visit to Post Office Bay, where a 200-year-old tradition of leaving and collecting postcards continues. Afterward, explore the underwater wonders around Champion Islet, one of the best snorkeling sites in the archipelago. End the day with a walk along Cormorant Point's olivine beaches, observing flamingos and other bird species around its lagoon.

Day 05

Day 5 : Departure From Baltra Island

Conclude your Galapagos adventure with a final stop at Baltra Island, where you'll disembark for your flight back to the mainland.

Learn about giant tortoise conservation and observe newly hatched tortoises and Darwin's finches.

Travel Tips

Pay attention to the meeting details provided upon arrival in Galapagos.

Wear comfortable clothing suitable for hot weather. Remember that Galapagos has a humid climate and its ambient temperature is above 22 degrees Celsius.

Take your identity card or passport with you, especially on your transfers in and out of the Galapagos Islands.

Remember that traveling by cruise ship can cause seasickness, we recommend that you take sea sickness pills with you.

These can only be taken once a day.

Be aware of the environmental impact and follow the national park's rules on conservation and respect for nature.

Weather Preparedness

It is advisable to bring a windbreaker jacket for when you want to enjoy the best view of the Galapagos Islands in our open air area.
